1 **[PROPOSED] ORDER**

4 (“Motion”) by SCI California Funeral Services, Inc., a California corporation dba Joshua

- 10 2. The Judgment is amended to reflect the intervention of “SCI California Funeral
11 Services, Inc. dba Joshua Memorial Park” as a Party to the Judgment, specifically a
12 “Non-Stipulating Party” pursuant to Judgment Sections 3.5.24 and 5.1.10., with a
13 Production Right pursuant to Section 5.1.10. in the amount of 122 acre-feet per year.
- 14 3. Joshua Memorial is authorized to Produce Groundwater from the Antelope Valley
15 Area of Adjudication, subject to Joshua Memorial’s compliance with the
16 requirements set forth in the Judgment and the Watermaster Rules and Regulations.
