IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

The Discovery Order for Phase 4 Trial, dated December 12, 2012 ("Phase 4 Discovery Order"), is hereby amended as set forth below, with the Phase 4 Discovery Order remaining unchanged in all other respects.

For each and every provision enumerating calendar years 2000, 2001, 2002, 2003, and 2004, every such provision shall also allow for a party to elect to respond for calendar years 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008, 2009, and 2010.

For any party claiming right to return flows resulting from use of native water - rather than from imported water - such claim is not within the scope of Phase 4 and is preserved for determination during later proceedings.
