1 **[PROPOSED] ORDER**

2 On September 8, 2016 the Court held a hearing regarding the election by Los Angeles
3 County Waterworks District No. 40 (“District No. 40”) for periodic payments of the award of
4 attorneys’ fees to the Wood Class, as ordered in the Order After Hearing on April 1, 2016, dated
5 April 25, 2016 and entered on June 17, 2016 (“Attorneys’ Fees Order”), and as clarified in the
6 Order Clarifying Order After Hearing on April 1, 2016, entered on June 28, 2016 (“Clarifying
7 Order”). All appearances were stated on the record.

8 IT IS ORDERED that the \$1,756,578.90 fee award against District No. 40, as ordered in
9 the Attorneys’ Fees Order and Clarifying Order, shall be paid in periodic payments, as provided
10 in Government Code section 984, as follows:

- 11 • 50% of the fees award owed by District No. 40 will be due within fifteen (15) days
12 after the Attorneys’ Fees Order and Clarifying Order become final after their
13 respective appeals, if the Appellate Court upholds the award of fees against
14 District No. 40;
- 15 • The remaining 50% will be paid in ten (10) annual installments, if the Appellate
16 Court uphold the award of fees against District No. 40;
- 17 • Installment payments will be made on September 1st of each year, beginning in
18 the first calendar year after the initial payment is made; and
- 19 • Interest, at the same rate as one-year United States Treasury bills as of January 1
20 of each year, will accrue to the unpaid balance of the judgment, and on each
21 January 1 thereafter throughout the duration of the installment payments the
22 interest shall be adjusted until the judgment is fully satisfied.

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24 Nothing in this Order shall prevent the parties from agreeing to make a payment on any
25 other terms.

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The court shall retain jurisdiction as provided in Government Code section 984,
subdivision (e)(4).
