CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE ON STATUS OF SETTLEMENT NEGOTIATIONS

Various parties reported on the status of the settlements and various parties filed requests for continuance of the September 27, 2010 Phase 3 Trial. A Further Case Management Conference is scheduled for July 29, 2010 at 9 a.m. to consider the requests for a continuance of the scheduled Phase 3 trial. The hearing will be held in the Santa Clara County Superior Court in Department 12 therein. Counsel may, but are not required to, appear by telephone through CourtCall. Further information and any further opposition to the request to continue the scheduled trial must be posted and filed no later than July 26, 2010. In order to consider the requests for a continuance the Court must have more details of the terms of the so-called Waldo settlement proposal and information specifying the parties who have not participated and would not be covered by the settlement as well as those who would be bound.
