## MINUTE ORDER RE: Expert Witness Testimony of Mr. Joseph Scalmanini

On December 22, 2010, an *ex parte* hearing request was made by California Water Service Company, City of Palmdale, Littlerock Creek Irrigation District, Los Angeles County Waterworks District No. 40, Palmdale Water District, Palm Ranch Irrigation District and Quartz Hill Water District (collective hereinafter referred to as "Requesting Parties") to permit, due to health reasons, designated expert witness, Mr. Joseph Scalmanini, to testify at the Phase 3 trial proceedings via web conference, to allow for a shortened testimony schedule, and additionally, to seal said request. The Court deemed this request to be an emergency and requested that objections thereto and any requests for a conference call be submitted to the Court by noon on December 23, 2010. Any party requesting a conference call with the Court shall notify Best, Best & Krieger and such conference call will be scheduled for December 24, 2010 at 9:00 a.m., with Best, Best & Krieger making the necessary arrangements for the call.

Comments were received from Attorneys Michael Fife, Michael Duane Davis, and Marlene Allen-Hammarlund.

The Court conducted a teleconference call on December 24, 2010 at 9:00 a.m. with the following attorneys present: Tom Bunn, Jeffrey Dunn, Michael Fife, Marlene Allen-Hammarlund, Stefanie Hedlund, Bradley Herrema, Bob Joyce, Robert G. Kuhs, Wayne Lemieux, Julie Riley, Christopher Sanders, and William Sloan.

Mr. Dunn, on behalf of the Requesting Parties, presented information regarding Mr. Scalmanini's health status, and their proposals for live video testimony for Phase 3 Trial and the shortened testimony schedule. Mr. Fife presented his concerns regarding the request for live video testimony and to the shortened testimony schedule.

The Court requested that Mr. Dunn lodge, under seal, a doctor's declaration regarding Mr. Scalmanini's health status and serve said declaration only to counsel in this action. Pending receipt of a doctor's declaration, the Court continued this hearing to December 29, 2010 at 9:00 a.m., to be conducted telephonically and limited to counsel only. All counsel are instructed to use the conference call information (phone number and passcode) provided by Best Best & Krieger for today's conference.

After further discussion with counsel, the Court instructed Mr. Dunn to complete the lodging, under seal, of the doctor's declaration regarding Mr. Scalmanini's health status and serve said declaration only to counsel in this action. The Court ordered counsel to meet and confer and discuss alternatives and to contact the Court for a further teleconference next week. The Court advised parties it will confirm the location of Phase 3 trial and will issue its order by January 4, 2011.
