**MINUTE ORDER: CASE MANAGEMENT CONFERENCE**

1. The Proposed Order Granting Lemieux & O'Neill's Motion to be Relieved as Counsel for Little Baldy Water Company has been submitted to the Court. The Court will sign the order and post the document to the Court's website as soon as possible.
2. The Court confirmed that Trial Phase 4 will commence on February 11, 2013 at 9:00 a.m., and is estimated to be completed within two weeks. The Court offered Santa Clara County Superior Court an alternative location for trial.
3. The Court conducted an open discussion on the Proposed Discovery Order for Phase 4 Trial and Proposed Case Management Order for Phase 4 Trial. Having reviewed the submissions by counsel, and having heard the arguments of counsel, the Court determined that it will issue its own Discovery Order for Phase 4 Trial and Case Management Order for Phase 4 Trial. The Court requested Word versions of certain Proposed Orders be submitted electronically to the Court, by email to [rwalker@scscourt.org](mailto:rwalker@scscourt.org).
4. Page 2, lines 22-25, in the Trial Setting Conference Statement posted to the Court's website on December 8, 2012 by Attorney Sheldon R. Blum, for the Blum Trust, is stricken from the record. The Clerk for the Los Angeles County Superior Court shall return the document to counsel. Counsel shall re-file the Trial Setting Conference Statement with the redactions, as ordered by the Court.
5. A Proposed Protective Order will be submitted by Attorney Robert Kuhs.
6. Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District's Demand for Exchange of Expert Witness Designation, posted to the Court's website on December 3, 2012 by Attorney Wesley Milliband, is withdrawn by counsel, as that item is expected to be included in the Court's Discovery Order.
