Tentative ruling issued 1/21/15.

The matter is argued by Mr. Blum on behalf of the Blum Trust and Mr. Bunn on behalf of Palmdale Water District ("PWD"). Mr. Bunn's request that his client, PWD, be added to the list of those parties who filed oppositions to the Blum MSJ/MSADJ is granted by the Court. With the addition of the PWD as an opposing party to the Blum MSJ/MSADJ, the Court adopts its tentative ruling and the Blum MSJ/MSADJ is denied.
