NATURE OF PROCEEDINGS:

As to the Wood Hearing held 8/3/2015, the Court makes findings the evidence supports the provision in the Wood Settlement, and the Court made a finding that there were no formal objections filed. A later objection filed by a party who was a member of the Wood Class but not objecting to anything on behalf of the Wood Class but only as to the effect that it had on Willis Class ownership of land of which he felt that he was a potential member of that class. That objection is overruled.

The Court, referring to the Wood Settlement Hearing held 8/3/2015, finds that the evidence presented is sufficient to justify the propriety and the appropriateness of the settlement. It is beneficial to the members of the Wood Class, and whether it becomes part of a final solution or not, depends upon what the court's findings are with regard to the global proposed settlement. It is all conditioned, except the finding of the Court as to the pumping and the average pumping which the Court found to be true based upon the testimony of Mr. Thompson.
