1 The motion of Antelope Valley Resource Conservation District, Intervenor, for an order
2 granting it leave to intervene in the case Antelope Valley Groundwater Cases, Judicial Council
3 Coordination Proceeding No. 4408, came on for hearing on December 13, 2022 at 9:00 a.m., at
4 191 N. 1st Street, San Jose, California, 95113, in Department 3 of the San Jose Superior Court.
5 Bradley T. Weeks, of Charlton Weeks LLP appeared on behalf of Antelope Valley Resource

8 Having read the motion, the memoranda and the declarations filed by the parties, and
9 having heard argument of counsel, the Court finds that the Antelope Valley Resource
10 Conservation District is entitled to intervene in the Antelope Valley Groundwater Cases, Judicial
11 Council Coordination Proceeding No. 4408.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED An evidentiary hearing will be scheduled to take evidence and for
14 the court to review and consider evidence and objections concerning the amount of Antelope
15 Valley Resource Conservation District's groundwater pumping rights, if any.

17 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED All parties who wish to engage in discovery shall meet and confer
18 regarding proposals for the discovery.

20 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED All parties who wish to participate in an evidentiary hearing shall
21 meet and confer regarding the date of the hearing, submission of evidence, and conduct of that
22 hearing.
