1 MR. JOYCE: YOUR HONOR, TWO ISSUES: ONE, I
2 ASSUME THAT ANY PRESENTLY DUE RESPONSIVE PLEADINGS ARE
3 DEFERRED UNTIL AFTER THE NEW PLEADING HAS BEEN FILED.

4 THE COURT: YES.

5 MR. JOYCE: SECONDLY, YOUR HONOR, IS THERE ANY
