24	As requested by the court on December 15, 2006, transmitted herewith is a proposed amended		
25	order after hearing on jurisdictional boundaries. It is in redlined format to show the changes from the		
26	original order. Concurrently herewith, we are submitting a clean copy of the proposed amended order.

A draft of this order was sent to the parties on December 20, 2006. Several comments were received. Pursuant to Rule 3.1312(b), Cal. Rules of Court, there follows a summary of the comments received to the draft order. The e-mail correspondence is also attached hereto. While changes were made in the proposed order, description and map in response to some of the comments, some disputes could not be resolved. Therefore, it is necessary to go forward with the hearing on the amended order that was scheduled by the court.

William Sloan, Attorney for U. S. Borax, suggested that the description of one of the excluded areas be changed from "the North Muroc area" to "a portion of the North Muroc area." This suggestion was accepted.

Lee Leininger, Attorney for the United States, suggested two changes in the language of the order and additionally suggested that the map be revised to include an additional area within Edwards Air Force Base. The order was revised in response to the comments. The map was also revised to include the additional area, there being no objection from other parties.

Henry Weinstock, Attorney for Tejon Ranch, suggested that the map show (1) the major faults (Neenach, Randsburg-Mojave, etc.), and (2) the Little Buttes (north of the Antelope Buttes). This suggestion was rejected, because it was felt that the only thing added to the base map should be the boundary as determined by the court. The base map itself is the standard U.S.G.S. topographical map of the Antelope Valley.

Bob Joyce, Attorney for Diamond Farming Company, asked that the map show township and range as well as section lines. The base map did show township, range and section lines, but the identification of the townships and ranges on the margins of the map were inadvertently omitted. Accordingly, this has been added to the proposed map.

Mr. Joyce also objected to the exclusion of the North Muroc area and the Leona Valley. However, the whole point of the amended order was to exclude these areas. Accordingly, this objection could not be resolved.

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1	Richard Zimmer, Attorney for Wm. Bolthouse Farms, requested that "superfluous findings" be		
2	omitted. However, all the findings in the amended order were in the court's original order, so none		
3	were deleted.
