28	management statement in advance of the March 8, 2	2010 Case Management Conference. The		

Court asked parties to address the setting for trial of the remaining phases of the trial. *See* Order
 Setting Hearing Date for Further Case Management Conference ("Order"), filed February 19,
 2010. Order at 2.

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A.

The next phase of trial should cover the issues of safe yield and overdraft.

The next logical phase of this case is to further define the status of the aquifer by
determining the safe yield of the basin aquifer and whether it is/was overdrafted. Safe yield and
overdraft are necessary precursors to issues such as prescription, appropriation, and other issues.
Accordingly, the following issues are appropriate for litigation in the Phase III trial:

- What constitutes (or defines) safe yield in the Antelope Valley Groundwater Basin? What is the amount of the safe yield in acre-feet per annum of the Antelope Valley Groundwater Basin?
 - 2. Is the Antelope Valley Groundwater Basin in a state of overdraft today? If yes, how long has this condition existed? If not, was the basin ever in overdraft, and when?


15 B. <u>Proposed Phase III trial schedule</u>.

16 The following proposed trial schedule is based on the Court's request that the parties 17 attempt to agree on a Phase III trial schedule with the trial commencing "in mid or late July 2010 18 or early August 2010." Order at 2. After discussions with counsel, there does not appear to be a 19 consensus on the trial date. The United States understands that a key expert witness, Mr. 20 Scalmanini, may not be available for most of August and therefore the Public Water Suppliers 21 prefer a July trial. The United States also understands that certain landowners and pumpers will 22 argue for an October trial date due to extensive preparation and expert witness development. 23 The United States agrees that the Phase III trial is likely to be longer and more fact-intensive 24 than the earlier two phases of trial and therefore does not object to a Fall 2010 trial. However, 25 consistent with the Court's request, the United States suggests the following schedule for 26 litigation in Phase III:

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1	1. Immediate: Commence written discovery for the purpose of disclosing facts		
2		related to the Phase III trial issues.	
3	2.	April 26, 2010: Deadline for the filing of experts' reports on the issues identified	
4		for litigation in the Phase III trial. All parties intending to present expert	
5		testimony at trial shall be required to file written expert reports. The report must	
6		contain a complete statement of all opinions the witness will express and the basis	
7		and reasons for the opinions, and the data or other information the witness	
8	considered in forming the opinions, and the witnesses' qualifications. The		
9	submission of expert reports will assist in minimizing discovery costs and		
10		increasing judicial efficiency by reducing discovery disputes.	
11	3.	May 26, 2010: Deadline for the filing of expert rebuttals to initial reports of	
12		experts. All parties intending to present rebuttal expert testimony at trial shall be	
13		required to file written rebuttal expert reports. The report must contain a	
14		complete statement of all opinions the witness will express and the basis and	
15		reasons for the opinions, the data or other information the witness considered in	
16		forming the opinions, and the witnesses' qualifications.
