7 Engineer Directorate (AFMC/412 CE/CL), Edwards AFB, California. Mr. Judkins may provide
8 expert testimony regarding water production and use at Edwards AFB, and the impact of
9 changing mission requirements, both current missions and potential future mission growth, on
10 the water needs of Edwards AFB.

12 3. Jared Scott, Chief, Industrial Facilities Branch, Air Force Materiel Command, Air
