NOTICE THAT on March 21, 2014, at 9:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, the United States will, and hereby does, move this Court by way of an ex parte application, for an order extending the briefing deadlines for the Federal Reserved Water Right claim by one month. Good cause exists for the relief sought.

#### MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITES

In support of this motion, the United States states:

- 1. By Minute Entry, dated February 19, 2014, the Court deemed the Federal Reserved Water Right claim submitted, subject to further briefing. The current briefing schedule states:
  - -Closing brief due 4/02/14;
  - -Opposition brief due 4/22/14; and
  - -Reply brief due 5/01/14.
- 2. On March 6, 2014 the Court heard the Antelope Valley East Kern Water Agency and Public Water Suppliers' Notice and Ex Parte Application to Continue Phase 5 Trial: Declaration of Jeffrey Dunn, wherein the movants explained that "Numerous parties have engaged in settlement discussion and settlement talks continue to progress. For this reason, AVEK and the Public Water Suppliers respectfully request that the Court grant this application for a short continuance to allow the parties to continue the settlement discussion."
- 3. By Minute Entry, dated March 6, 2014, the Court granted the AVEK and Public Water Suppliers' motion and "encouraged continued face-to-face good faith settlement discussions." The Court continued the trial date for one month, from March 10 to April 7.
- 4. The parties have been engaged in settlement negotiations, meeting every week day beginning March 12, 2014. These discussions are on-going and have been fruitful.
- 5. An extension in the briefing schedule will allow parties to devote all their case time and resources to the settlement effort. A negotiated settlement, in turn, may curtail or eliminate issues the parties may otherwise argue in post-trial briefing, thus saving the parties' and the Court's time and resources.
- 6. Accordingly, the United States requests a one month extension of the briefing schedule.
