This cause coming on to be heard on appeal from the decision of the United States Board of Land Commissioners to ascertain and settle the private land claims in the state of California under an act of Congress, approved March 3^d 1851, on a transcript of the proceedings and decision of said Board of Commissioners, and of the papers and evidence upon which said decision was founded; and on additional evidence filed before this court, and it appearing to the court that said transcript and the notice of appeal have been duly filed, according to law, and counsel for the respective parties having been heard;

It is ordered, adjudged and decreed that, the decision of said Board of Commissioners be and hereby is in all things reversed.

And it is further adjudged and decreed that the claim of the appellant to the lands called Liebre claimed in this case is good and valid, and the same are hereby confirmed to him to the extent of eleven square leagues of land, and no more, within the boundaries described.

in the Front, to wit, The "Salinas de Portoroz" on
the North East, the "Cuesta de la Bellota" on the
South, and the tract called "Los Almendros"
on the West; the place of Los Alcarrizos.

Provided that should the quantity of
land within said boundaries be less than
Eleven Square Leagues, then compensation
is hereby made of such less quantity.
