Well groundwater extraction (water pumped) for the years 2011 and 2012 are required for Antelope Valley Water Adjudication, Phase 4. Antelope Park has two wells which are used alternately to fill storage tanks.

Antelope Park groundwater extraction estimate is based on Edison records of power consumed in KWH (kilowatt hours) and Edison pump efficiency test. The pump efficiency test provides an estimate of pumping rate in KWH/Acre-Ft. Calculations are based on latest Edison pump efficiency tests conducted June 5, 2012.

Three pumps are the source of electricity usage on the Edison meter: (1) well pump #3, (2) well pump #4, and (3) Booster Pump #2 (Booster Pump #1 us for emergency use only). Well pump #3 and Well Pump #4 are used alternately to pump groundwater into a holding tank so the rate of power consumption will be the average of the two pumps.

The Booster pump (aka. pressure pump) pumps water from the holding tank into a pressure tank for distribution to customers. Thus overall power consumption for pumping water will be the well average consumption plus booster pump consumption.

For any period in which KWH electricity usage is available, water pumped can be computed by

Water Pumped in Acre-Ft =
$$\frac{KWH \ usage}{966.5 \frac{KWH}{Acre-Ft}}$$

Using Edison yearly electricity usage records with this calculation we get:

^{***} Note. 2012 water usage is for 11 months only, excluding December 2012.

Notes.

The following problems (challenges) were encountered in computing electricity usage.

- (1) Some Edison bills were missing from those filed with the court. Each bill gave meter reading for current month and for previous month so readings could be filled in unless there were two successive months missing. In that case, electricity usage could be computed for multiple months using months for which there were bills with meter readings. The December KWh usage includes two months of usage, including November which was missing. So in the end, accurate electricity usage was computed for entire years with available Edison bills.
- (2) There were meter "turnovers", similar to an odometer turnover. Meter went to 99,999 and then to 00,000. That was accounted for in the computations.
- (3) Meter was changed March 16, 2012. The old meter gave meter readings from which electricity usage could be computed. The new meter did not give meter readings, only electricity KWh usage. Fortunately all billings were available for months in which the new meter was used.
