
ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF PARTIAL SATISFACTION OF JUDGMENT

1 On or about September 22, 2011, the Court entered an Amended Final Judgment Approving
2 Willis Class Action Settlement ("Judgment"), which, in pertinent part, awarded Judgment for fees,
3 costs and an incentive award on behalf of the Willis Class, and against defendants Los Angeles
4 County Waterworks District No. 40, City of Palmdale, Palmdale Water District, Littlerock Creek
5 Irrigation District, Palm Ranch Irrigation District, Quartz Hill Water District, California Water
6 Service Company, Rosamond Community Services District, Phelan Piñon Hills Community
7 Services District ("PPHCSD"), Desert Lake Community Services District, and North Edwards
8 Water District (collectively "Defendants") in the total amount of \$2,075,174.18. Pursuant to an
9 agreement between PPHCSD and the Willis Class, PPHCSD has fully paid its share of the
10 Judgment. The Willis Class covenants and agrees not to seek further monetary relief from
11 PPHCSD in connection with the Judgment and acknowledges that PPHCSD has fully satisfied its
12 share of the Judgment.

13 IT IS HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGED THAT the Judgment approving Willis class action
14 settlement, entered on September 22, 2011, in favor of the Willis Class against Defendants has
15 been partially satisfied as to that portion of the monetary judgment for attorneys' fees, costs,
16 incentive award, and supplemental attorneys' fees paid by Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services
17 District. This Acknowledgment only releases Defendant Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services
18 District from the monetary fee award in the Judgment, and does not release any party, including
19 Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District, from the non-monetary provisions of the
20 Judgment.
