TO ALL PARTIES AND TO THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:

Pursuant to the Court's Case Management Order for Phase 4 Trial dated December 12, 2012 and the Court's subsequent amendments to that Order (collectively, the "Phase 4 CMO"), Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District ("PPHCSD") hereby submits the following response and declaration as supplemental and additional information to information previously provided by PPHCSD:

- (1) Absent a stipulation from all parties participating in the Phase 4 trial as to the foundation and authenticity of the Certificates of Accuracy records previously provided through Exhibit E of PPHCSD General Manager Don Bartz's declaration dated January 31, 2013, and as stated in PPHCSD's Discovery Disclosure on December 21, 2012, PPHCSD intends to call as a witness during the Phase 4 trial an employee from "Pump Check," which is the third-party vendor that inspected the flowmeter on PPHCSD's Well 14. PPHCSD anticipates Pump Check's testimony will relate to Pump Check's employee's training and experience for evaluating the accuracy of a flowmeter such as the flowmeter on PPHCSD's Well 14; the evaluation by Pump Check of PPHCSD's Well 14 during 2010 and 2012; and, the Certificates of Accuracy created by Pump Check following Pump Check's evaluation of PPHCSD's Well 14 (i.e., Exhibit E of Mr. Bartz's declaration dated January 31, 2013).
- (2) The Declaration of PPHCSD provided below by and through its General Manager, Don Bartz, is pursuant to the Phase 4 CMO, referred to herein as the PPHCSD *Supplemental* Declaration. The PPHCSD *Supplemental* Declaration is made solely for the purpose of this action and more specifically for the Phase 4 Trial, based upon such information and documents as are presently available to and specifically known by PPHCSD. Although PPHCSD has undertaken significant efforts since its formation in 2008 to evaluate and enhance services to its residents and customers, including among other things, water service as previously provided by County of San Bernardino Special Districts Department, further discovery or evaluation may supply additional facts or documents, add meaning to the known facts, or establish entirely new conclusions. The following responses are given without prejudice to PPHCSD's right to produce evidence of any such additional facts or documents subsequently discovered, recalled, or otherwise responsive to

further discovery, investigation, research, or analysis. Accordingly, PPHCSD reserves the right to amend or to supplement responses provided herein, though absent further orders or appropriate requests, no such affirmative obligation exists to amend or supplement the responses provided herein.

Notwithstanding the foregoing comments, and consistent with the Phase 4 CMO and the Court's comments regarding the same, the PPHCSD *Supplemental* Declaration provides ample, credible, and admissible information to enable parties to understand and agree to the quantity of groundwater produced by PPHCSD from the Antelope Valley Adjudication Area during the time period relevant to Phase 4 *and* identification of the beneficial uses of that water.

Based upon this sufficient and admissible information, the parties should agree to the quantities of groundwater produced for calendar years 2011 and 2012 and the beneficial uses for which such water was produced by PPHCSD so that deposition and trial testimony from PPHCSD are not necessary for the Phase 4 Trial.

DECLARATION OF DON BARTZ

I, Don Bartz, declare as follows:

- 1. I am the General Manager for Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District ("PPHCSD"), which is a party to this groundwater adjudication commonly referred to as the Antelope Valley Groundwater Cases. I make this Declaration on behalf of PPHCSD in response to the Court's Phase 4 CMO and to provide supplemental and additional information to my declaration in this matter dated January 31, 2013, and I am authorized to do so. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth in this Declaration, and if called as a witness, could and would testify competently to such facts under oath.
- 2. As I stated in paragraph 10 of my January 31, 2013 declaration in this matter, PPHCSD was amending with the State Water Resources Control Board ("SWRCB") its Notice of Extraction and Diversion of Water for 2010 to reflect production as 1,110.45 af. PPHCSD has now submitted that amendment to the SWRCB. Attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "H" (my January 31, 2013 declaration contains Exhibits A through G) is a true and correct copy of PPHCSD's amended Notice of Extraction and Diversion of Water for 2010.

- 3. Also, as I stated in paragraph 13 of my January 31, 2013 declaration, PPHCSD has Well Logs for Well 14, which illustrate the flowmeter readings for that well, which is the only PPHCSD well located within the Antelope Valley Adjudication Area. Exhibit D of my January 31, 2013 declaration are true and correct copies of Well 14's Well Logs for calendar years 2011 through November 30, 2012. Attached to this Declaration as Exhibit "I" are true and correct copies of Well 14's Well Logs for calendar years 2005 through 2010.
- 4. Exhibits H and I represent PPHCSD's records, prepared in accordance with PPHCSD's customs and practices, including recordation of the information based upon the water year from October 1 through September 30.
- 5. As General Manager for PPHCSD, I am familiar with the customs and practices for creating and maintaining records, including for each and every one of PPHCSD's records attached as an exhibit to this Declaration. Each such record was made within the scope of duties for the PPHCSD employee who created the record, and was done at or near the time the act was completed. Specifically as to the Well Logs (Exhibit I), PPHCSD employees are trained on how to identify, and then to identify, the data for each column on the Well Log for each day of each month as indicated in the rows, with the month denoted at the top of the Well Logs. Having reviewed each such record attached to this Declaration, I believe each record to be a true, accurate and complete copy of the original.
