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TO THE HONORABLE COURT AND ALL PARTIES AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD HEREIN:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that Cross-Defendant and Cross-Complainant, Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District ("PPHCSD"), pursuant to Evidence Code §§ 452 and 453, hereby requests that the Court take judicial notice of the following items and the contents thereof (as reflected in the attached exhibits) for the Phase Four Trial:

- Exhibit "A": Certified Copy by the Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk for the 1. County of Los Angeles of Quitclaim Deed recorded as 99-2052340.
- Exhibit "B": Certified Copy by the Local Agency Formation Commission of the 2. County of San Bernardino of Certification of Completion for formation of Phelan Piñon Hills Community Services District.

Item numbers 1 and 2 above are the proper subject of judicial notice pursuant to Evidence Code § 452, subdivisions (c) and (h).

Evidence Code § 452(c) states that: "Judicial notice may be taken of the following matters to the extent that they are not embraced within Section 451: Official acts of the legislative, executive, and judicial departments of the United States and of any state of the United States." Case authorities demonstrate that "official act" has a broad meaning and has been applied in various contexts. "Official acts" include records, reports, and orders of administrative agencies. (Rodas v. Speigel (2001) 87 Cal.App.4th 513, 518.) A presumption exists that the official duty in acquiring data (and information) has been regularly performed. (Cal. Evid. Code § 664; see also, Furman v. Department of Motor Vehicles (2002) 100 Cal.App.4th 416, 422.) Judicial notice was taken of the Environmental Protection Agency's Office of Pesticides Programs, Pesticide Regulation Notice 96-4 as an "official act" of the federal government within the meaning of Evid. Code § 452(c). (See, Etcheverry v. Tri-Ag Service, Inc. (2000) 22 Cal.4th 316, overruled on unrelated grounds.) Judicial notice has also been properly taken under Evid. Code § 452(c) as to the history of legislation addressing fraud in the auto industry. (See, Casella v. Southwest Dealer Services, Inc. (2007) 157 Cal.App.4th 1127.) Proper notice was taken under Evid. Code § 452(c) of a legislative history document even though the document was ultimately of little or no help in

ascertaining legislative intent given uncertainty of who prepared the document and for what purpose. (See, Lodge at Torrey Pines Partnership (2008) 42 Cal.4th 1158, 1172 fn. 5.) The foregoing authorities demonstrate the breadth of "official act" under Evid. Code § 452(c) includes notices relating to regulations, or documents relating to legislative history, and may even include otherwise "irrelevant" documents.

Here, Item numbers 1 and 2 are "official acts" of the County governments because both are government publications in the form of records or reports from administrative agencies under the umbrella of the executive branch. Also, the "official" seal stamped upon each Item certifies that and authenticates the document, as an "official record" for purposes of an exception to the hearsay rule pursuant to Evidence Code § 1280 (Official Records Exception), namely because this record was produced within the scope of duty of a public employee, and the method and time of preparation are such as to indicate its trustworthiness.

The foregoing circumstances demonstrate that Item numbers 1 and 2 are not "reasonably subject to dispute and are capable of immediate and accurate determination by resort to sources of reasonably indisputable accuracy," thereby allowing this Court to take judicial notice of such pursuant to Evidence Code § 452(h).

Ultimately, judicial notice of Items 1 and 2, and the contents thereof, as attached hereto as Exhibits A and B, respectively, is proper pursuant to Evidence Code § 452(c). Evidence Code § 453 authorizes the Court to take judicial notice as requested by PPHCSD given the sufficiency of the foregoing information. Accordingly, PPHCSD respectfully requests the Court take notice of Items 1 and 2 and the contents of the same as reflected in Exhibits A and B attached hereto.
