AND 5 YOU'D HAVE TO -- WE'D HAVE TO REVIEW THE MAP TO SEE 6 WHETHER THERE'S ANY IN THE AREA YOU'RE TALKING ABOUT. 7 ON EXHIBIT 258, YOU WERE IDENTIFYING PURPLE 8 DOTS THAT WOULD IDENTIFY WELLS AND THEN SOME CIRCLED 9 NUMBERS. DO YOU RECALL THAT? 10 YEAH. LET ME FIND THAT. A 11 SURE. 12 Q 13 (PAUSE IN THE PROCEEDINGS.) 14 15 THE WITNESS: WELL, LET'S GO FROM THE MAP. HERE I 16 17 CAN SEE. BY MR. SHEFFIELD: 1.8 SURE. AND I JUST HAVE A GENERALIZED Q 19 OUESTION. WHEN YOU WERE GETTING INFORMATION THAT 20 PLOTTED THESE DOTS OUT, WERE YOU ABLE TO ASCERTAIN 21 WHETHER OR NOT THESE ARE ACTIVE PUMPING WELLS AT THE 22 TIME THAT YOU FOUND INFORMATION ABOUT THEM? 23 THE INFORMATION SIMPLY STATES THERE WAS A 24 Α WELL. AS FAR AS BEING AN ACTIVE WELL -- BECAUSE YOU 1 CAN HAVE A WELL THAT IS A CLOSEOUT WELL AND IT WILL 2 STILL SHOW UP ON A MAP AND IT'S NOT AN ACTIVE WELL. 3 MAYBE SOMEBODY'S PUMPING WATER OUT OF IT. 4 5 DID YOU HAVE ANY DISTINCTION BETWEEN WHAT YOU WERE SEEING IN THE PLOT OF THESE DOTS, WHETHER THESE 6 7 WERE ACTIVELY PUMPING WELLS?
