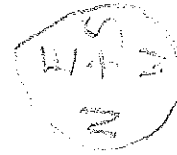

As you know, our Technical Specialist performed a free energy efficiency test on one or more pumps at your facility on March 22, 2012. We thank you for the opportunity to provide this service, and appreciate your interest in the performance of your pumps.
