The Notice to be sent to Class members shall be in all material and substantive respects in the form attached as Exhibit A.
- Within sixty (60) days of the entry of this Order, Los Angeles County Waterworks 2. District No. 40 shall compile a list reflecting to the best of its ability the members of the class as

3	3. Within ninety (90) days of entry of this Order, Los Angeles County Waterwork

5	4. Within ten (10) business days of completion of the above mailing, Los Angeles		
6	County Waterworks District No. 40 shall file and serve a Declaration attesting to service of the		
7	Notice, and shall make available a list identifying all persons to whom they made the mailing.		
8	5. Class counsel shall establish a web site to update class members as to developments
