

1 3. Within ninety (90) days of entry of this Order, Los Angeles County Waterworks
2 District No. 40 shall cause the Notice to be sent by first class mail to all such persons.

3 4. Within ten (10) business days of completion of the above mailing, Los Angeles
4 County Waterworks District No. 40 shall file and post a Declaration attesting to service of the
5 Notice, and shall make available a list identifying all persons to whom they made the mailing.

6 5. Class counsel shall establish a web site to update class members as to developments
7 in the case. Class counsel shall post on the case docket any proposed entries to the web site, which
8 shall be as objective as possible. Any party may object to a proposed entry within five (5) business
9 days of its posting, in which event the matter will be considered by the Court at its next following
10 Hearing. In the event there is no objection within five business days, Class Counsel may make the
11 entry on the web site.

12 6. Within ten (10) business days of the completion of the above mailing, Los Angeles
13 County Waterworks District No. 40 shall publish a Summary Notice, in the form attached hereto as
14 Exhibit B, in *The Antelope Valley Press* and in _____.

15 7. Class members shall have 30 days to exclude themselves from the Class. Any
16 exclusion form received within 35 days of the mailing of notice shall be deemed timely. Any person
17 who timely returns the exclusion form or identifies him/herself as not owning property within the
18 Basin or as a pumper shall be excluded from the Class. All other persons shall remain Class
19 members. The above deadlines shall be subject to extension by the Court upon a showing of good
20 cause.

21 6. Within ten (10) business days of the deadline for persons to exclude themselves from
22 the Class, Los Angeles County Waterworks District No. 40 shall file and serve a list of all persons
23 who have requested that they be excluded from the Class or who have identified themselves as
24 pumpers, as well as any other communications it has received in response to the Notice.
