ORDER MODIFYING CLASS DEFINITION

The Proposed Order Modifying Class Definition and Allowing Parties to Opt In to the Plaintiff Class, submitted by Plaintiff Willis on or about May 20, 2008, is modified by the Court to reflect the date of August 15, 2008 on page 4, lines 3-5, and shall now read as follows: "On or before Aug. 15, 2008, LA. County Waterworks District No. 40 shall compile a list of Class Members and propose a means for disseminating the Class Notice to such persons, which it shall post on the case website." Expert disclosures shall be posted by noon on <u>June 27, 2008</u>. Any party unable to comply may seek ex parte relief upon a showing of good cause in accordance with Santa Clara County Complex Litigation Guidelines upon notice.
