MINUTE ORDER RE: **CONTINUANCE OF TRIAL SETTING CONFERENCE**

The Court has previously scheduled a Case Management Conference on March 13, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. for trial setting purposes as well as continued hearing on several discovery and other motions. One of the orders of Court was that the parties were to prepare case management statements with suggestions as to what should be involved in the next phase of trial, in terms of prescription issues, allocation issues, storage issues, return flows, and the like, as well as time estimates for the next phase of trial.

Justice Ronald Robie, who has been acting as a volunteer mediator, has indicated that the parties have requested that the Trial Setting hearing on March 13, 2012, be continued approximately 30 days since there is an ongoing settlement conference with Justice Robie set for April 2 and 3, 2012. That request is granted and there will be a trial setting conference in the Los Angeles Superior Court on April 17, 2012 at 9:00 a.m.

The court will expect all other motions and the case management conference to proceed as scheduled on March 13, 2012 at 9:00 a.m. While there is a possibility that several of the parties may settle their claims against each other, it does appear that a trial will be necessary for those non-settling parties and a prove-up as to the others.

This matter was not reported.
