FIFTH AMENDED CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER

The Court's current Case Management Order is hereby amended as follows: The Phase IV Trial is only for the purpose of determining groundwater pumping during 2011 and 2012. The Phase IV Trial shall not result in any determination of any water right, or the reasonableness of any party's water use or manner of applying water to the use. The Phase IV Trial will not preclude any party from introducing in a later trial phase evidence to support its claimed water rights including, without limitation, evidence of water use in years other than 2011 and 2012. All parties reserve their rights to produce any evidence to support their claimed water rights and make any related legal arguments including, without limitation, arguments based on any applicable constitutional, statutory, or decisional authority.
