LEASE

This LEASE, made by and between H. Peter and Ipbi Kim Meyer referred to in this LEASE as "Lessor", and Calandri/SonRise Farms, LP. referred to in this LEASE as "Lessee", is made upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Term of LEASE

This LEASE shall be for a period of 2 years, Twenty Four (24) consecutive months beginning January 1, 2004 and ending December 31, 2005, with Two one-year options. Rental for the option years will be increased by 5% over that of the preceding year.

This LEASE shall encompass approximately Eighty (80) acres, at SW corner of Gaskell and 90th St. W., the legal description of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Lessor reserves the right to sell the Leased premises at any time during the term of this LEASE, and in the event of such sale, the buyer would purchase said property subject to the existing LEASE.

2. Purpose for which Premises are to be Used

The Leased premises are to be used by Lessee for the purpose of farming; and for such purpose Lessee is authorized to cultivate, irrigate, fertilize, fumigate, and do all other acts which may be reasonable or necessary in connection with such farming operation. Lessee shall conduct its farming in conformity with good agricultural operations. Lessee shall comply with all applicable State and Federal laws.

3. Rental

Lessee agrees to pay by way of rent for the term of this LEASE the sum of Eight Thousand Dollars (\$8,000.00) per year, which will be payable upon the execution of this LEASE. Thereafter, the rent shall be due and payable annually, in advance.

4. Occupancy

Lessee shall be entitled to use of the Leased land, and any well(s) that may currently exist on the Leased Property. Lessee agrees to purchase and maintain during the term of this LEASE, at Lessee's sole cost and expense, and with companies acceptable to Lessor, public liability insurance for protection against liability to persons or property or claims arising as an incident to the use of, or resulting from, an accident or event occurring in or about the premises. The limits of liability under said public liability insurance shall be no less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for any one accident, and one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) for property damage. Lessor shall be named as an additional insured.

5. Utilities

Lessee agrees to pay for the utilities used in connection with the existing wells, if any, located on the property, the use of which shall be

exclusively by and for the Lessee. If utility extensions are required, same shall be at the expense of Lessee.

6. Equipment

The only equipment being leased in connection with this agreement is any existing well(s), pump(s), electric motor(s), engine(s), panel(s), storage tank(s) and barn(s), which shall be the exclusive property of Lessee to use during the term of this LEASE.

7. Condition of Premises

Lessee acknowledges that it has inspected the demised premises, that the same are in good and tenantable condition. Lessor makes no representations or warranty with regard to the condition of the premises. Lessee shall not remove, alter, modify or demolish any building or other improvement located upon the demised premises or any improvement thereon.

It shall be the obligation of Lessee to maintain, if any, well, pump, motor, engine, panel, barn or storage tank and underground main line, in as good condition as Lessee takes them, subject to ordinary wear and tear, Lessee shall be obligated to repair any damages and maintain any well, pump, motor, engines, panel, barn, storage tank and underground main line caused by Lessee's negligence of their agent or employees.

If any or all of the wells servicing the Leased property are rendered inoperable by any act of God, except lightning but including earthquakes, Lessee shall not be responsible for repairing same.

In the event any or all of said wells servicing the subject property become inoperable, Lessor shall have the option of repairing said well or wells at their own expense as quickly as possible, or terminating the LEASE.

If LEASE is so Terminated:

(a) Lessee shall have the right to remain on the property long enough to harvest any growing crop, if they so desire.

(b) Lessee shall be refunded, pro rata, any advance rent based on the monthly use of the premises up to the date Lessee actually leaves the premises.

7A. Wells - Lessee's Option

Notwithstanding Paragraph 7 above, if Lessor refuses to repair said well or wells, Lessee may choose to have said well or wells repaired at its own expense, in which event Lessor cannot terminate the LEASE as set forth above.

8. Compliance With Law

Lessee shall at Lessee sole expense, promptly comply with all applicable statutes, ordinances, rules, regulations, orders, covenants and restrictions of record, and requirements (hereinafter collectively referred to as "regulations") in effect during the term or any part of the term hereof, whether said regulation was in effect at the time of the signing of the LEASE or became effective thereafter, regulating the use by Lessee of the premises, including, but not limited to State and/or Federal Superfund Laws, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, the Clean Water Act, the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide & Rodenticide Act, the Hazardous Waste Control Act, or the Porter-Cologne Act. Lessee shall not use nor allow the use of the premises in any manner what would tend to create waste or a nuisance. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing. Lessee shall not allow or suffer the use, release or discharge on, in, around or under the premises of any material, chemical, substance or waste which is classified or regulated as a "toxic" or "hazardous" material, substance or waste by any applicable governmental or regulatory authority or agency (collectively "hazardous waste"). Lessee may apply during the term of the LEASE the insecticides, pesticides, fumigants and fertilizer, so long as said application is in compliance with all applicable regulations.

8A. Indemnification

Lessee shall indemnify, defend and hold Lessor harmless for any and all costs, expenses, including attorney's fees, or damages that Lessor is forced to expend or becomes liable to expend, as a result of the Lessee's use of the premises.

9. Mechanics' Liens and Encumbrances

Lessee will not permit any mechanics', laborers', or materialmens' liens to stand against the demised property for any labor or material furnished to Lessee, or claimed to have been furnished to Lessee or to Lessee's agents, contractors, or subleases in connection with work of any character performed on the demised premises, or claimed to have been performed on the demised premises, at the direction or insistence of Lessee; provided, however, that Lessee shall have the right to contest the validity of the amount of any such claims or lien provided Lessee gives Lessor reasonable security that may be demanded by Lessor with immediate notice of any such claim, lien, encumbrance and/or action arising out of any claim for labor or material furnished for the use or benefit of the demised premises.

10. Right of Entry

Lessor or his agents shall have the right to enter upon the demised premises at any reasonable time for the purpose of inspecting the condition thereof, or for the purpose of showing the same to any prospective purchaser or tenant thereof, or to conduct any necessary studies (e.g. soil) so as not to

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ADDENDUM TO LEASE

This Addendum to Lease supplements the Lease Agreement to which it is attached between H. Peter Meyer and Ipbi Kim, as Lessor and Calandri/SonRise Farms, LP, named as Lessee.

1. Water Supply. Lessee is familiar with the wells and the well equipment mentioned in the Lease and accepts them in their present condition. Charges for the electrical energy services provided to pumping facilities upon the premises shall be billed directly to Lessee. Under no circumstances shall Lessor be liable to Lessee or others by reason of crop or other loss or damage due to irrigation water. Water from the wells located on the lease premises shall be used only on the lease premises and in connection not export any such water to other lands nor use the same for any purpose other than the growing crops on the premises.

2. Disclaimer of Warranties. Lessor makes no warranties whatsoever concerning the character, quality, quantity or suitability of the soil, prevailing climatic conditions, irrigation water and/or other factors that might pertain to the ability to successfully produce crops pursuant to this Lease.

3. Mannered of Use of Premises. Lessee shall:

- a. Conduct its farming operations and related activities on the premise according to the highest standards of farm husbandry practiced in the vicinity.
- b. Maintain the premises and all parts thereof in a neat and orderly condition and not allow trash or debris to accumulate, nor use the premises as a dumping ground.
- c. Avoid waste of irrigation water.

4. Insurance. Lessee shall maintain in full force and effect at all times (a) adequate workers' compensation insurance; and (b) comprehensive general liability insurance, (rather than public liability insurance as mentioned in the Lease) with the limits as stated in the Lease.

LANCASTER AREA FARM LEASE

This Lancaster Area Farm Lease (hereinafter "Lease"), by DIAMOND FARMING COMPANY, a California corporation ("Landlord"), whose address is Post Office Box 81498, Bakersfield, CA 93380-1498, Telephone (661) 845-5275, Facsimile (661) 845-5262 and CALANDRI/SONRISE FARMS, LP, a California limited partnership ("Tenant"), whose address is 40445 27TH Street West, Palmdale, CA 93551, Telephone (661) 945-0516, Facsimile (661) 945-2930.

WITNESS

1. PREMISES. Landlord does hereby lease to Tenant approximately 304.95 acres of farmland (the "Premises") located in Los Angeles County, California as shown on Exhibit "A."
2. RENT. Rent payable by Tenant to Landlord for the term hereof shall be \$250.00 per acre for those acres reflected on Exhibit "A" for a total rental amount due of \$76,237.50. Such amount shall be due upon execution.
3. TERM. The term of this Lease shall be for the period beginning upon execution and ending on December 31, 2004.
4. WATER. Tenant shall have the exclusive right to utilize the irrigation well and pump on Exhibit "A" designated as DW134/PE140. Tenant shall have the non-exclusive right to utilize the irrigation well and pump on Exhibit "A" designated as DW224/PE093. Tenant shall not export water produced on the Premises off of the Premises. Landlord shall be responsible for all above and below-ground repair and maintenance. Grimmway Farms shall have the right to share the use of DW224/PE093. Grimmway Farms shall reimburse Tenant an amount equal to \$90/ACFT for that volume of water its pumps from DE224/PE093.
5. UTILITIES. During the term of this Lease, utilities to DW134/PE140 shall remain in Landlord's name. Tenant shall reimburse Landlord for its use of natural gas. Tenant shall have the obligation to supply diesel fuel to DW224/PE093. Tenant shall at its sole cost and expense hire and Grimmway Farms to service all diesel and natural gas engines at the manufactures recommended service intervals at a rate equal to \$10.00 per ACFT.
6. MAINTENANCE AND REPAIR. Landlord shall at its own cost and expense keep and maintain the aboveground and belowground portions of wells and pumps in good condition and repair. Tenant shall have the obligation to check and maintain the fluid levels of the pumping equipment between regular equipment service intervals. Tenant shall provide Grimmway Farms with notice of 250 hour intervals for diesel engines and 400 hour intervals of natural gas engines during its use of the wells and pumps to enable Grimmway Farms to complete the regularly scheduled servicing intervals for the equipment in a timely manner. Lessee shall at its sole cost and expense hire and reimburse Grimmway Farms to service all engines at the manufactures recommended service intervals.
7. FARMING OPERATIONS. Tenant shall utilize the Premises only for the growing of onions and incidental uses thereto and is authorized to take all action deemed necessary to conduct its farming operation. All operations incident to Tenant's use of the Premises shall be carried on in accordance with reasonable husbandry practices utilized in the region. Tenant shall take the appropriate action to prohibit irrigation water from escaping on to adjoining lands or public highways. Reasonable efforts will be

efforts will be made by Tenant to prevent the use by the general public and unauthorized individuals of private roads located on the Premises. Tenant will make reasonable efforts to prevent the spread of noxious weeds, rodents and other vertebrate pests on the Premises. Further, Tenant will make reasonable effort to minimize the accumulation of any rubbish or waste on the Premises and shall maintain all fences for the term of the Lease on the Premises in the same condition as when received.

8. ACCEPTANCE OF PREMISES. By entering into this Lease, Tenant accepts the Premises in its present condition as Tenant has made such inspections of the Premises as Tenant deems necessary to evaluate the Premises and its suitability for Tenant's farming operation, including an assessment of the soil condition due to the use of pesticides.

9. RELATIONSHIP OF PARTIES. This Lease shall not be construed as creating a relationship of principal and agent or of a joint venture, partnership or other business association between Landlord and Tenant, it being understood and agreed that no provisions contained in this Lease, nor any acts of the parties hereto, shall be deemed to create any relationship other than that as specified herein.

10. EXPENSES. Tenant shall pay for all the obligations and costs incurred in the farming of the Premises, including, without limitation, labor, seed, pesticides, machinery, except as otherwise provided for herein.

11. INSURANCE.

A. Tenant agrees to maintain in effect during the term of this Lease, primary forms of insurance coverage, in the amount of at least \$1,000,000 to protect against claims, demands or liabilities in the performance or nonperformance of this Lease to the extent that insurance of such risks is reasonably available. Tenant shall provide written notice to Landlord as to the existence or nonexistence of such insurance, policy number and company name. Tenant agrees to name Landlord as "additional insured" and upon request to submit a certificate of insurance evidencing such coverage and that such insurance may not be canceled without thirty (30) days prior notice to Landlord.

B. Tenant agrees to maintain during the term of this Lease, at its own expense, Workers' Compensation Insurance (or a Certificate of Consent to Self-Insure) for individuals carried on its payroll.

12. WASTE. Tenant shall not unreasonably commit or permit others under Tenant's control to commit on the Premises waste or a nuisance or any other act that could disturb the quiet enjoyment of Landlord or any other occupant of adjacent Premises.

13. INSPECTION. Tenant shall permit Landlord and its agents, at all reasonable times, to enter the Premises and to use the roads established on the Premises for the purpose of inspection for compliance with lease terms and to exercise its rights for posting notices and other lawful purposes.

14. IMPROVEMENTS AND STRUCTURES. Structures, installations and facilities placed on the Premises by the Tenant shall be and remain the Premises of Tenant during the lease term. Upon lease termination, Tenant shall have the right to remove portable structures, installations, irrigation facilities, equipment and/or personal Premises of Tenant, except where such facilities and improvements were

improvements were installed as part of the maintenance of the leasehold. In any event, Tenant shall be entitled to remove all portable sprinkler irrigation facilities, tail water pumps and incidental irrigation facilities provided by Tenant.

15. **HAZARDOUS MATERIAL.** "Hazardous Material" as used herein shall mean any hazardous or toxic substance or material which is or becomes regulated by any local, state or federal authority. Tenant shall utilize all chemicals, pesticides, fertilizers or other materials consumed in the farming operation in compliance with all then existing applicable federal, state and local laws and regulations.

If the presence of Hazardous Material on the Premises is caused by Tenant during the term of this Lease and results in contamination in violation of the laws and regulations in existence at the time the Hazardous Material was utilized, then Tenant shall pay all clean-up costs which result therefrom. However, no action shall be brought against Tenant under this paragraph more than one (3) years after any alleged breach of the obligations stated herein.

16. **GENERAL INDEMNIFICATION.** Tenant shall indemnify, defend and hold Landlord, its employees, agents, successors, assigns and anyone acting on its behalf, harmless from all claims, judgments, damages, liabilities, penalties, losses, attorneys' fees and costs which result from or arise during or after the term of this Lease from any negligence of Tenant in the performance of its activities and farming operations on the Premises.

Landlord shall indemnify, defend and hold Tenant, its employees, agents, successors, assigns and anyone acting on its behalf, from and against all claims, damages, liabilities, attorneys' fees and costs which arise during or after the term of this Lease from negligence of Landlord in its activities concerning the Premises.

17. **TAXES.** Tenant shall comply with all lawful demands of the County Assessor in reporting Premises owned by Tenant and located on the Premises and shall pay all taxes, assessments and charges attributable to Tenant's crops, structures, improvements, machinery and other Premises placed on the Premises by and owned by Tenant.

Landlord shall pay all other real property taxes and assessments levied upon the Premises including irrigation facilities and equipment placed on the Premises by Landlord for Tenant.

18. **AGRICULTURAL PROGRAMS.** Landlord shall have responsibility to maintain compliance with any governmental programs in which the Premises are involved such as the FSA program.

19. **ATTORNEYS' FEES, ARBITRATION AND VENUE.** Any controversy between the parties regarding the performance or interpretation of this Lease, or any claim arising therefrom or as a result of a breach thereof, shall be submitted to binding arbitration on the written request of one party after service of the request on the other party. Arbitration shall be settled in accordance with the Commercial Arbitration Rules of the American Arbitration Association and judgment upon the award rendered by the arbitrator(s) may be entered in any court having jurisdiction.

If any party to this Lease shall bring any action or initiate arbitration for relief against the other, declaratory or otherwise, arising out of this Lease, the losing party shall pay to the prevailing party, a reasonable sum for attorneys' fees incurred in arbitration, bringing a suit and/or enforcing any judgment granted therein. Any judgment or order in such action or arbitration award shall contain a specific provision providing for the recovery of attorneys' fees and costs incurred in enforcing such judgment. Any arbitration or action shall be brought in Kern County, California as the proper place of venue since the last act to make this a binding Lease occurred in Kern County.

20. TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE. Time is hereby expressly declared to be of the essence in this Lease and all terms and conditions herein.

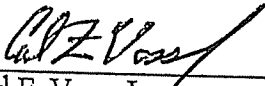

LEASE

This LEASE, made by and between George M. Lane referred to in this LEASE as "Lessor", and Son Rise Farms, referred to in this LEASE as "Lessee", is made upon the following terms and conditions:

1. Term of LEASE

This LEASE shall be for a period of twenty-four (24) consecutive months beginning January 1, 2002 and ending December 31, 2003, with One (1) one year options.

This LEASE shall encompass approximately One Hundred Sixty, (160) acres the legal description of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.

Lessor reserves the right to sell the Leased premises at any time during the term of this LEASE, and in the event of such sale, the buyer would purchase said property subject to the existing LEASE.

2. Purpose for which Premises are to be Used

The Leased premises are to be used by Lessee for the purpose of farming; and for such purpose Lessee is authorized to cultivate, irrigate, fertilize, fumigate, and do all other acts which may be reasonable or necessary in connection with such farming operation. Lessee shall conduct its farming in conformity with good agricultural operations. Lessee shall comply with all applicable State and Federal laws.

3. Rental

Lessee agrees to pay by way of rent for the term of this LEASE the sum of Twenty Four Thousand Dollars, (\$24,000.00) per year, which will be payable upon the execution of this LEASE. Thereafter, the rent shall be due and payable annually, in advance.

4. Occupancy

Lessee shall be entitled to use of the Leased land, and any well(s) that may currently exist on the Leased Property. Lessee agrees to purchase and maintain during the term of this LEASE, at Lessee's sole cost and expense, and with companies acceptable to Lessor, public liability insurance for protection against liability to persons or property or claims arising as an incident to the use of, or resulting from, an accident or event occurring in or about the premises. The limits of liability under said public liability insurance shall be no less than one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00) for any one accident, and one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000.00) for property damage. Lessor shall be named as an additional insured.

5. Utilities

Lessee agrees to pay for the utilities used in connection with the existing wells, if any, located on the property, the use of which shall be

exclusively by and for the Lessee. If utility extensions are required, same shall be at the expense of Lessee.

6. Equipment

The only equipment being leased in connection with this agreement is any existing well(s), pump(s), electric motor(s), engine(s), panel(s), storage tank(s) and barn(s) which shall be the exclusive property of Lessee to use during the term of this LEASE.

7. Condition of Premises

Lessee acknowledges that it has inspected the demised premises, that the same are in good and tenantable condition. Lessor makes no representations or warranty with regard to the condition of the premises. Lessee shall not remove, alter, modify or demolish any building or other improvement located upon the demised premises or any improvement thereon.

It shall be the obligation of Lessee to maintain, if any, well, pump, motor, engine, panel, barn or storage tank and underground main line, in as good condition as Lessee takes them, subject to ordinary wear and tear, Lessee shall be obligated to repair any damages and maintain any well, pump, motor, engines, panel, barn, storage tank and underground main line caused by Lessee's negligence of their agent or employees.

If any or all of the wells servicing the Leased property are rendered inoperable by any act of God, except lightning but including earthquakes, Lessee shall not be responsible for repairing same.

In the event any or all of said wells servicing the subject property become inoperable, Lessor shall have the option of repairing said well or wells at their own expense as quickly as possible, or terminating the LEASE. Lessee shall properly maintain well and pump and if outside maintenance and/or repair are required, Lessee shall pay the first \$2500.00 of any such repairs or costs of any one calendar year before requesting Lessor to make any repairs.

If LEASE is so Terminated:

(a) Lessee shall have the right to remain on the property long enough to harvest any growing crop, if they so desire.

(b) Lessee shall be refunded, pro rata, any advance rent based on the monthly use of the premises up to the date Lessee actually leaves the premises. No pro-rata refund of rent for well outage if crop is harvested or will be.

7A. Wells - Lessee's Option

Notwithstanding Paragraph 7 above, if Lessor refuses to repair said well or wells, Lessee may choose to have said well or wells repaired at its own expense, in which event Lessor cannot terminate the LEASE as set forth above.

8. Compliance With Law

Lessee shall at Lessee sole expense, promptly comply with all applicable statutes, ordinances, rules, regulations, orders, covenants and restrictions of record, and requirements (hereinafter collectively referred to as "regulations") in effect during the term or any part of the term hereof, whether said regulation was in effect at the time of the signing of the LEASE or became effective thereafter, regulating the use by Lessee of the premises, including, but not limited to State and/or Federal Superfund Laws, the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act, the Clean Water Act, the Federal Insecticide, Fungicide & Rodenticide Act, the Hazardous Waste Control Act, or the Porter-Cologne Act. Lessee shall not use nor allow the use of the premises in any manner what would tend to create waste or a nuisance. Without limiting the generality of the foregoing. Lessee shall not allow or suffer the use, release or discharge on, in, around or under the premises of any material, chemical, substance or waste which is classified or regulated as a "toxic" or "hazardous" material, substance or waste by any applicable governmental or regulatory authority or agency (collectively "hazardous waste"). Lessee may apply during the term of the LEASE the insecticides, pesticides, fumigants and fertilizer, so long as said application is in compliance with all applicable regulations.

8A. Indemnification

Lessee shall indemnify, defend and hold Lessor harmless for any and all costs, expenses, including attorney's fees, or damages that Lessor is forced to expend or becomes liable to expend, as a result of the Lessee's use of the premises.

9. Mechanics' Liens and Encumbrances

Lessee will not permit any mechanics', laborers', or materialmens' liens to stand against the demised property for any labor or material furnished to Lessee, or claimed to have been furnished to Lessee or to Lessee's agents, contractors, or subleases in connection with work of any character performed on the demised premises, or claimed to have been performed on the demised premises, at the direction or insistence of Lessee; provided, however, that Lessee shall have the right to contest the validity of the amount of any such claims or lien provided Lessee gives Lessor reasonable security that may be demanded by Lessor with immediate notice of any such claim, lien, encumbrance and/or action arising out of any claim for labor or material furnished for the use or benefit of the demised premises.

10. Right of Entry

Lessor or his agents shall have the right to enter upon the demised premises at any reasonable time for the purpose of inspecting the condition thereof, or for the purpose of showing the same to any prospective purchaser or tenant thereof, or to conduct any necessary studies (e.g. soil) so as not to

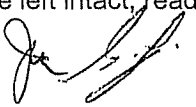
interfere with Lessee's farming. Lessor shall provide Lessee with notification prior to entering upon the property to conduct any such study or showing.

11. Default of Lessee

If any payments shall be due and unpaid after fifteen (15) days written notice of default, or if any default shall be made in any of the covenants or agreements on the part of Lessee contained in this LEASE, or in the event Lessee is adjudicated as bankrupt or insolvent, or has a receiver appointed to receive the assets of Lessee, or has a Trustee appointed for Lessee after a petition has been filed under the Bankruptcy Act of the United States, or if Lessee shall make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, or if Lessee shall vacate or abandon the demised premises, then in such event Lessor shall have the right at its election, then or at any time thereafter, to re-enter and take possession of the demised premises and terminate this LEASE, in which event Lessee hereby covenants to peaceably and quietly yield up to Lessor the demised premises. Lessor shall also have the right, with or without resuming possession of the premises or terminating the LEASE, to sue for and recover all rents and other sums, including damage at any time and from time to time accruing hereunder together with such other rights as may be provided Lessor by law. Lessor may further have the right, at its option, without terminating this LEASE, to relet the premises for the remainder of the term to such tenants, and at such rentals as Lessor may agree upon and Lessee agrees to pay such deficiency to Lessor and further agrees to pay to Lessor, when ascertained, all costs and expenses incurred in such reletting. No re-entry or taking of possession of the demised premises by Lessor shall be construed as an election on Lessor's part to terminate the LEASE unless a written notice of such intention is given to Lessee or unless the termination be decreed by a court of competent jurisdiction.

12. Surrender of Premises

At the expiration of the term of this LEASE or any sooner termination of this LEASE, Lessee agrees to quit and surrender the premises and all appurtenances thereon and in good state and condition as reasonable use and wear thereof will permit. Lessee shall remove all debris associated with Lessee's farming operation, leaving the land free of any reservoirs, pits, or earthen mounds. Well head discharge, pipes, valves, & adapters to be left intact, ready to accept portable aluminum pipe main line connection, at termination of tenancy.



13. Notices

Any notice required or permitted to be given by Lessor to Lessee shall be deemed given when mailed in a sealed wrapper by the United States Postal Service.

14. Miscellaneous

(a) Except as may be inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this LEASE, no right or remedy granted or reserved to Lessor shall be intended to be exclusive of any other right or remedy which Lessor may otherwise have, and each and every such right or remedy shall be cumulative and in addition to any right or remedy given hereunder, or now or hereafter existing by law or in equity or by statute;

(b) Lessee waives for itself and those claiming under it all rights now and hereafter existing to redeem the demised premises after termination of Lessee's right to occupancy by order or judgment of any court;

(c) Reasonable attorney's fees and other expenses incurred by Lessor in enforcing any provision of this LEASE or in any action or proceeding in which Lessor is successful by reason of the default by Lessee or by anyone holding under Lessee complying with any requirement of this LEASE or incurred by Lessor by reason of any action to which Lessor shall be and shall constitute additional rent under the LEASE provided that in the event of litigation concerning same, the losing party shall pay the reasonable expenses, including reasonable attorney's fees and costs of the prevailing party;

(d) No waiver by Lessor of any breach by Lessee of any of his obligations hereunder shall be deemed to be a waiver of any subsequent or continuing breach of the same or any other agreement under this LEASE;

(e) In the event Lessee holds over after termination of the LEASE, such holding over shall not be considered as or being a renewal of the LEASE, but shall be construed solely as a tenancy from month to month under the same terms and conditions as are provided in this LEASE and at the same rental rate, monthly prorated;

(f) This LEASE, subject to the provisions on assignment and insolvency, shall be binding upon and inure to the benefit of the respective successors and assigns of the parties;

(g) Any transfer of the LEASE by Lessee or any assigns of Lessee by operation of law or voluntary assignment with or without the consent of Lessor shall not diminish or affect the direct and primary liability of Lessee under this LEASE;

(h) If part of this LEASE be declared unenforceable by any court or in violation of any law, such part shall be inoperative, and the remainder of this LEASE shall be binding upon the parties hereto.

(i) If any State, County or Local government agency causes any type of legislation, ordinance, etc. that changes the amount of water available to or for the subject property, Lessor realizes such alteration may affect the amount and or cost of water available to Lessee. If such "adjudication" of water rights takes place, Lessee shall have sixty (60) days to evaluate the impact of such adjudication on the operation of Lessee's business. If Lessee determines, in its sole discretion, that such an adjudication shall have an adverse impact, then Lessee may terminate this Lease, without any additional cost, penalty, or consideration for such termination, upon thirty days' written notice to Lessor.

15. First Right of Refusal

It is agreed that so long as Lessee is not in default of any terms, conditions or covenants of this Lease, or any extension thereof, Lessee shall have the first right of refusal to re-lease the demised premises. After the expiration of the Lease contained herein, or any extension thereof, Lessor will notify Lessee in writing if it is Lessor's intent to again lease the demised premises, specifying the rental rate and all other terms. Lessee shall have fifteen (15) days from receipt of said notice to notify Lessor in writing of Lessee's election to again lease the demised premises. Should Lessee fail to notify the Lessor in writing of Lessee's election to lease demised premises, Lessee's First Right of Refusal shall be deemed waived. If Lessee notifies Lessor in the affirmative to lease the demised premises, the Lessor, within a reasonable period of time, shall draft leases and deliver them to Lessee for execution. Upon delivery of said leases, Lessee shall have fifteen (15) days in which to execute and return said leases to Lessor.

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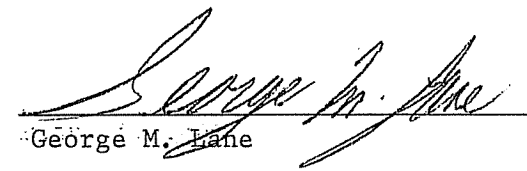
