AND RELATED CROSS-ACTIONS

1 On June 9, 2016, counsel for the Wood Class submitted an order related to the counsel's request  
2 for clarification of the judgment. At the hearing, the court indicated its order was clear and that no  
3 additional order regarding the attorneys' fees was necessary. Therefore, the Wood Class supplemental  
4 order is inappropriate.

5 However, should the court be inclined to sign the supplemental order, the order should be clear  
6 that the Small Public Water Suppliers ("Small Districts") may pay the judgment over 10 years. Counsel  
7 for the Wood Class continues to maintain that the 10 year payment is unavailable under the order because  
8 the fees were awarded on a several basis and, counsel argues, this is contrary to law.

9 However, the court made it clear at the hearing that the Small District's would have 10 years to  
10 pay the attorneys' fees award pursuant to the order. Accordingly, the Small Districts request this be  
11 expressly included in the Order for Clarification. For the convenience of the court, we have provided a  
12 sample order with this language.
