 Los Angeles County Waterworks District No. 40, Quartz Hill Water District, Littlerock Creek Irrigation District, Palm Ranch Irrigation District, Palmdale Water District, the City of Palmdale, the City of Lancaster, and Rosamond Community Services District (the "PWAs") and Southern California Edison Company ("Landowner") (collectively, the "Stipulating Parties") enter into this Stipulation Between Certain Public Water Agencies And Southern California Edison Company Concerning Land Ownership, Prior Groundwater Production And Proposed Allocation Of Groundwater Rights ("Stipulation") through their respective counsel of record. This Stipulation is based on the matters set forth in Section I, below.

I.

RECITALS

A. Landowner owns land overlying the Antelope Valley Groundwater Basin (the "AV Basin"). (For purposes of this Stipulation, the term "AV Basin" shall mean the Antelope Valley Groundwater Basin as determined and defined by the Honorable Jack Komar in his March 12, 2007 Revised Order After Hearing on Jurisdictional Boundaries.)

B. Landowner served its (i) Response To December 12, 2012 Discovery Order for Phase 4 Trial and the Non-Expert Witness Designation ("Discovery Response") and (ii) Stipulation In Lieu Of Deposition Testimony For Phase 4 Trial ("Declarations") on all parties in the instant action.

II.

TERMS OF THE STIPULATION

A. Based on the Landowner's Discovery Response and Declarations, the PWAs have no objection to the Court making the following findings of fact:

- Landowner currently owns land overlying the AV Basin, which land is comprised of Assessor Parcel Numbers ("APN") identified in Exhibit A to this Stipulation (the "Subject Property").
- (2) As of January 1, 2013, Landowner currently uses the Subject Property as follows: for the operation of the Antelope Substation, the Whirlwind Substation, 28 other substations, and numerous transmission corridors in the AV Basin.

- (3) Landowner used the Subject Property during calendar years 2011 and 2012 as follows: for the construction and operation of the Antelope and Whirlwind Substations, as well as 28 other substations and numerous transmission corridors in the AV Basin that do not currently have groundwater wells.
- (4) Landowner produced the following quantities of groundwater from the AV Basin during calendar years 2011 and 2012:
- a. The Whirlwind Substation property identified in Exhibit A produced approximately 24.2 acre-feet per year ("AFY") in 2011 and 3 AFY in 2012.
- b. The Antelope Substation property identified in Exhibit A produced approximately 6.29 AFY in 2011 and 2 AFY in 2012. The Antelope Substation property produced approximately 80.17 AFY in 2010.
- (5) Landowner or its predecessor in interest to the Subject Property produced the following quantities of groundwater from the AV Basin during the period from January 1, 2000 through December 31, 2004 (the "2000-04 Time Period"):
- a. Landowner did not own the land that comprises the Whirlwind Substation in the 2000-04 Time Period, and the substation did not exist at that time. Thus, the Whirlwind Substation property did not produce groundwater in the 2000-04 Time Period.
- b. The Antelope Substation property produced approximately 2 AFY in the 2000-04 Time Period.
- (6) Landowner or its predecessor used the groundwater described in this Section II-A for "reasonable and beneficial" uses on the Subject Property. For purposes of this Stipulation, the term "reasonable and beneficial" shall have the meaning as understood in Article X, Section 2 of the California Constitution.

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

Antelope Substation

With regard to Southern California Edison's Antelope Substation, please refer to the Declaration of Jorge A. Rosa, Jr., and that declaration's Exhibit E, for meter records taken by Mr. Rosa. These meter records commenced on July 8, 2010 and ended on July 1, 2011. The meter reads indicate that approximately 7.97 acre-feet was produced from the groundwater well at the Antelope Substation during the last 5 months of 2010 and that approximately 6.29 acre-feet was produced between January 11, 2011 and July 1, 2011.

In addition to the meter reads, records from contractors performing grading work at the Antelope Substation indicate that approximately 70.0 acre-feet of water was produced by H&H Grading, Inc. from the Substation's groundwater well from April 27, 2010 to July 8, 2010. These records from H&H Grading, which were not available to Edison at the time of its Response to December 12, 2012 Discovery Order for Phase 4 Trial, are attached to this Exhibit E. The H&H Grading records and the Edison meter reads indicate that approximately 77.97 acre-feet of water was produced from the Antelope Substation well in 2010. Additionally, Professional Electrical Construction Services ("PECS") estimated from the capacity of its water trucks, which were filled with on-site groundwater, and the frequency of their use, that PECS utilized 2.2 acre-feet of water in 2010 for its construction activities.

Whirlwind Substation

With regard to Southern California Edison's Whirlwind Substation, information from Southern California Edison's contractors can be used to estimate construction-related water usage at the Whirlwind Substation in 2011 and 2012. Cattrac Construction performed grading, compacting, and dust control work from March through June of 2011, during the construction of the Whirlwind Substation. Cattrac used various sources of water (refer to Exhibit O as well), including the on-site groundwater wells at Whirlwind Substation. Based on the total cubic yards of earth moved during the construction period by Cattrac, which is estimated to be in excess of 711,200 cubic yards, and Cattrac's estimate that 25 gallons of water are required to grade each cubic yard of earth, Cattrac used approximately 17,780,000 gallons, or 54.6 acre-feet, of water. Cattrac's records indicate that Cattrac obtained 41.2 acre-feet of water from non-well sources such as Rosamond Community Services District or RMR Water Trucks. Cattrac determined, therefore, that approximately 13.4 acre-feet was produced from the on-site groundwater wells for construction-related use at Whirlwind Substation in 2011.

Additionally, from February to December of 2011, PECS performed non-grading construction work and utilized water from the on-site groundwater wells. PECS informed Edison that this construction work required the production of approximately 10.8 acrefect of water from the groundwater wells. PECS's estimate of water production is based on the number of water trucks used each day, the estimated number of loads per truck per

day, the capacity of the water trucks, and the number of days PECS worked during each month it performed construction activities at the Whirlwind Substation.

In total, PECS and Cattrac, combined to produce 24.2 acre-feet of water from the on-site wells at Whirlwind Substation in 2011 for construction-related uses.

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

With regard to Southern California Edison's Antelope Substation, non-well water was utilized in 2010 and 2011 in connection with construction activity at the Antelope Substation. Kindness General Contractors, Inc. ("KGC"), a contractor that performed dust control and stormwater pollution prevention work at the Antelope Substation, utilized an off-site hydrant. KGC's attached records indicate that it purchased approximately 12.87 acre-feet from Los Angeles County Department of Public Works Waterworks District. There is no known off-site water use at the Antelope Substation during 2000-04 or in 2012.

With regard to Southern California Edison's Whirlwind Substation, no other known sources of water were utilized from 2000 to 2004 since the Substation did not exist, and Edison did not own the property, at that time. In 2011, off-site water sources were used during construction activities to supplement the water used from the on-site wells. Specifically, Cattrac Construction's invoices, attached, indicate that 37.64 acre-feet of water was purchased from RMR Trucks (3,066 loads of 4,000 gallons/load) and 3.6 acre-feet from Rosamond Community Services District for use in 2011. The records of KGC, Inc. indicate that Rosamond CSD provided an additional 0.34 acre-feet of water in 2011. In summary, in 2011 approximately 41.58 acre-feet of water was obtained from a source other than the groundwater well.

In addition to Edison's Antelope and Whirlwind Substations, and as set forth in the Declaration of Jorge A. Rosa, Jr., Edison owns 28 other substations and transmission corridors in the adjudicated Antelope Valley Groundwater Basin that do not currently have wells. Construction activities at these substations and transmission corridors utilize non-well water. By way of example only, construction activity associated with portions of Edison's Tehachapi Renewable Transmission Project has utilized at least 8.5 acre-feet of water from other sources within the Antelope Valley Groundwater Basin in 2012. (See attached records from H&H Grading entitled TRTP WP-1 Water Usage Log, and attached invoices from Los Angeles County Department of Public Works Waterworks District.)

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Cross-Defendant Southern California Edison ("Edison") responds to the Court's December 12, 2012 Discovery Order for Phase 4 Trial ("Discovery Order") as follows.

I. Reservation of Rights

Edison objects to the Discovery Order's abbreviated discovery period. Until the December 11, 2012 Case Management Conference before the Court, there was no determination as to the scope of the Phase 4 trial. Prior to the December 11th Case Management Conference, parties submitted various proposals regarding the scope of the Phase 4 trial, some of which proposed a trial on discrete issues such as return flows or prescription and would not have included a "prove-up" of parties' water rights claims. While Edison responds to its utmost ability here based its investigation to date, Edison is continuing its investigation and reserves the right to further supplement this response as additional information becomes available. Edison further notes that it has reviewed its prior water rights claim submitted in December 2011 and the basis for that claim, and has engaged in subsequent investigation since the filing of the initial claim, which has resulted in a more accurate claim at this time.

II. Responses Regarding Edison's Antelope Substation

1. Response to Section 1.1 of the Discovery Order

- A. Edison owns, occupies, or otherwise controls property in Los Angeles County identified by the following Assessor Identification Number(s): APN 3203034806, 3203034811, 3203034810, 3203034815, 3203034814, 3203034809, 3203034813, 3203034808, 3203034816, 3203034812, 3203034807 (collectively, all eleven parcels referred to as the "Edison Antelope Substation Property").
- B. Edison is the record title owner for all of the Edison Antelope Substation Property. Edison has owned APN 3203034806 since 1952. As stated below, this is the parcel on which a groundwater well is located to serve the Edison Antelope Substation Property. Edison has owned APN 3203034807 since 2007. Edison has owned APNs 3203034811, 3203034810, 3203034815, 3203034814, 3203034809, 3203034813, 3203034808, 3203034816, and 3203034812 since 2008. Edison is inquiring into prior ownership from 2000 forward of the parcels other than APN 3203034806 that comprise the Edison Antelope Substation Property.

- C. A groundwater well existed on the Edison Antelope Substation Property, on parcel APN 3203034806, from 2000-04 and 2011-12.
- D. A groundwater well was operated on the Edison Antelope Substation Property, on parcel APN 3203034806, from 2000-04 and 2011-12.
- E. Edison estimates, based on information currently and reasonably available to it, that the quantity of water, measured in acre feet per year ("AFY"), that is pumped from the well(s) described above in Section II.1.C-D is:

Construction activities at Edison substations are required over time to maintain and expand the capacity of Edison's existing infrastructure in order to meet service demands.
 - G. Edison does not pump groundwater off-site.
- H. The Edison Antelope Substation Property was and is used as a 500 kV electrical substation in 2011 and 2012.
- I. The Edison Antelope Substation Property is not utilized for agricultural purposes.
 - K. Edison claims 2 AFY as the reasonable and beneficial use for its property

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during operations of the Antelope Substation, and 14 AFY during periodic construction periods at the Substation.

As held in City of Los Angeles v.
