
Dear Counsel:

This correspondence is in reference to the Declaration of Jeffrey V. Dunn Re Status of Service of Process to assure that we are all in agreement as to what the Court ordered regarding service of process.

I admit at this point to not being entirely clear of what the Court has ordered since the process of service has occurred over a long period of time, and since the Court has made several orders in this regard. If I am reading the Declaration correctly, it sounds as though there is a group of landowners in Kern County, not subject to filing a Notice of Extraction since they are not in Los Angeles County, and who own under 100 acres, which if they are pumping more than 25 acre feet per year, are being left out of the lawsuit.
