Here's what I have been able to find out:

First, the state well identification numbers you ask for 24-5, 27-5, and 35-2 are in my message to you immediately below your question.

As for the UTM coordinates, the District does not have UTM coordinates (or latitude / longitude) coordinates for all of its wells. The coordinates that the District does have, as well as the addresses of the wells, are located on the well driller's reports, which were produced to you. I hope that helps.

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
