## AMENDED CASE MANAGEMENT STATEMENT

This Amended Case Management Statement is provided pursuant to the Court's request and is an update on the status of the Phase 3 trial and settlement efforts.

Twelve expert depositions have been taken. About seven expert depositions remain, including some now being scheduled. Some depositions have been continued because the experts had not completed their work. Furthermore, some parties have indicated they may de-designate experts based on the Court's upcoming case management order. The case should go to trial as scheduled.

Justice Robie ordered four lawyers representing the "Waldo Group" to meet and confer with the Public Water Suppliers. There have been settlement discussions between the Public Water Suppliers and members of the Waldo Group. The Waldo Group, which may include fewer parties than previously represented to the court, seems to be working against the Robie settlement process.
