"Homeowners are insulated from the facts of life about our serious groundwater overdraft because they nearly always get water when they turn on their faucets," Skelton went on. "Hardly anybody realizes how much skill and ilanning has gone into this kind of service. Fewer yet are aware how dangerously close we are to being unable to provide enough good quality water to our people without supplemental water from the State Water Project."
