DEFENDANT JUANITA EYHERABIDE'S
CASE MANAGEMENT STATEMENT

TO THE COURT AND ALL PARTIES OF RECORD:


Defendant Juanita Eyherabide, sued as Roe 2303, provides the following Case Management Statement. Juanita Eyherabide and the Eyherabide Sheep Co. own and operate a large livestock operation consisting of substantial tracts of land, some of which is located in the Antelope Valley and within the Basin. Pursuant to this Court's order certifying the Wood class, the Wood class

1 members were defined as, to paraphrase, private persons or entities within the Basin that have been
2 pumping less than 25 acre feet of water per year during any year from 1946 to present.

3 Eyherabide is undertaking an investigation into her historic use of groundwater in the
4 Antelope Valley to determine whether she ever met the definition of a Wood class member.
5 Additionally, Ms. Eyherabide does not recall ever communicating with Wood class counsel McLachlan,
6 nor does she recall receiving any proposed settlement. Ms. Eyherabide opted out of the Wood class upon
7 learning that there existed a certified class to which she may not belong and in order to preserve her
8 claims to groundwater in the basin.
