The City of Los Angeles, along with many of the parties to this action met have met repeatedly with Justice Robie, most recently on October 1 and 2, 2012 and have arrived at a general framework for settlement. The parties have scheduled multiple intensive drafting meetings to develop a comprehensive settlement document and will meet again with Justice Robie on November 29 and 30, 2012.
