- Informing the Watermaster about changes in the anticipated production volume or intended use.

Conditional Consent to Use Existing Water Well within PWD RE: Boundaries - Lot 131 of TTM 60148 (APN 3023-006-067)

Dear Ms. Fitzpatrick,

The Palmdale Water District (PWD) has reviewed the request from Pacific Communities Builder, Inc. (PCB) to reactivate an existing well located at Lot 131 of TTM 60148 (APN 3023-006-067) for the purpose of temporary construction water use in support of the Pacific Mesquite development. The well is located within the boundaries of the adjudicated Antelope Valley Groundwater Basin and within the service area of PWD.

Under Section 18.5 of the Antelope Valley Groundwater Judgment, no new or reactivated groundwater production may occur within a water purveyor's boundaries without that purveyor's written consent.

Accordingly, PWD conditionally grants consent to PCB for use of the subject well, subject to the requirements below. This consent is not final until all pre-use conditions are satisfied and verified by the District.

#### Conditions of Approval:

- 1. Purpose and Duration
  - Use is limited to non-potable construction purposes only (e.g., grading, dust control).
  - Authorization is valid for a maximum period of twelve (12) months from the date of this letter. Any extension must be requested in writing and approved by PWD.
- Water Metering and Reporting
  - A totalizing flow meter shall be installed before operation begins.
  - Monthly meter readings and usage logs shall be submitted to both PWD and the AV Watermaster by the 10th of each month.
