NOTICE OF MOTION AND MOTION *IN LIMINE* TO ESTABLISH THE UNITED STATES' LEGAL ENTITLEMENT TO A FEDERAL RESERVED WATER RIGHT AND TO LIMIT THE SCOPE OF EVIDENCE NECESSARY AT TRIAL

TO THE PARTIES AND THEIR ATTORNEYS OF RECORD:

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that, on May 13, 2013 at 9 a.m. or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard in a department to be determined of the Superior Court of California, County of Los Angeles, cross-defendant United States of America ("United States") will move the Court for an order establishing the United States' legal right to federal reserved water rights for Edwards Air Force Base ("EAFB") and Plant 42, and the remaining burden of proof related to those rights. The United States files this motion pursuant to Code of Civil Procedure sections 187 and 404.7, California Rules of Court, rules 3.504(c) and 3.1112(f), and the Court's January 17, 2013, First Amendment to Case Management Order for Phase Four Trial. This motion is based on the grounds that the applicable United States Supreme Court decisions and the documents attached to the accompanying Memorandum in Support of Motion in Limine establish that the United States is entitled to federal reservations of ground water from the Antelope Valley Aquifer, for military purposes. As a consequence, the United States seeks:

- (1) a ruling on the United States' legal entitlement to a reserved water right for EAFB and Plant 42,
- (2) to limit or eliminate the need for evidence at trial related to the volume or location of annual pumping from the Antelope Valley aquifer at the time of the reservations or land acquisitions, and
- (3) to limit the evidence the United States must produce at trial to
 - (a) proof of federal ownership;

- (b) demonstration of the military purposes at EAFB and the Plant 42; and
- (c) a showing of the amount of water necessarily reserved for current and future military purposes.
