In addition to the 23 case management conference, the Court has set oral argument on the United States' Motion for 24 Judgment on the Pleadings on September 21st, and an October 10th trial date for the determination 25 of adjudication boundaries. 26 The United States' motion for judgment on the pleadings argues that this adjudication is 27 not a comprehensive McCarran Amendment general stream adjudication, and therefore the Court 28

lacks jurisdiction over the United States. The United States contends that surface water in the

watershed is the primary source of recharge of groundwater in the Antelope Valley groundwater basin and that the tributary surface water has been excluded from this adjudication. The United States believes the facts presented on the face of the Cross-Complaint and facts judicially noticeable are sufficient for a judgment on the pleadings. Nonetheless, if the Court determines to hear evidence on the surface water contribution to the Antelope Valley groundwater basin, the United States respectfully requests that the Court so inform the parties so that the appropriate declarations may be prepared and submitted.\frac{1}{2}
