I am a licensed Civil Engineer in the State of California.

### Please summarize your business experience

1969-1975: Engineer with Cal Trans in Southern California

1976-1979: Engineer with the California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) in Southern California working exclusively on water utility rate cases and other water-related items on PUC-regulated systems throughout the state.

1979-2000: Dominguez Water Corporation - Operations and Construction Manager, followed by Director of Regional Strategic Business Units. I was responsible for overseeing the operations and providing engineering services for the Dominguez system as well as its subsidiary companies in the Antelope Valley (which includes the Lancaster system), Kern River Valley and Redwood Valley systems.
