* RESCLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA MARIA ESTABLISHING THE SANTA RAPRADA WATER FURTEYORS AGENCY AS THE RIGHTY TRADUCE WHICK DECISIONS ARE TO BE MADE AND TRANSMITTED PORSHANT TO THE WATER SUPPLY RETENTION AGRESHOUTS

WHEREAS, on June 25, 1985, the City of Santa Maria entered into an agreement with the Santa Barbara County Flood Control and Water Conservation District ("District") designated "Water Supply Retention Agreement", Model I, 12/11/84, as amended by First, Second & Third Amendments, ("WHAA") and is, pursuant to the WERA, one of the "Contractors" to which "Retained Rights" were assigned pursuant to the WERA; and

WHENEAS, this entity is a member of the Sente Berbarg Water Purveyor's Agency ("SENTA"), a joint powers agency formed on Nevember 16, 1982 to, among other things, develop water and water supplies and to coordinate water planning and operations and relations with other agencies; and

WHENEAS, Article 5(c) of the WSRA provides that the Contractors under the WSRA shall make all decisions relating to the reteined rights and shall transmit those decisions to the District, who shall communicate them to the State of California, Department of Water Resources ("DWR") or shall transmit those decisions to a "designated representative of the Contractors" for communication to DWR and "....shall organize themselves to enable the making and transmission of such decisions"; and

WHEREAS, to facilitate the joint decision-making contemplated and required by the MSRA, it is the desire and intention of the parties to the WSRA to use the SBWPA as the forum for the making and transmission of such decisions and to designate the Engineer Manager of the SBWPA as their representative to communicate such decisions to either the District or the DWR,

MON, THERROOM, IT IS HERENT RESOLVED AS POLLOWS:

- 1. The Santa Barbara Water Purveyork Agency is bereby acknowledged, ratified, and designated as the untity referred to in Article 5(c) of the WSBA, as the organization through which the making and transmission of all decisions relative to the WSBA shall be made.
- 2. Any decision of the SEWPA relating to the VSRA shall be subject to ratification by contractors holding a majority of the Ratained Rights excisting at the time of the decision in compliance with the provisions of Article 5(c) of the WSRA.
- 3. Ratification of any decision by this entity shall be in writing, communicated to the Engineer Manager of the SHUPA.
- antity stepresentative to transmit and communicate any decisions of the SBWPA ratified by Contractors holding a majority of the Retained Rights under the WSRA.
