Name	Subject and Brief Description of Testimony
Daniel Wilke	Mr. Daniel Wilke is the Irrigation Department Manager for Wm. Bolthouse Farms, who drafted 3 Declarations with calculations and worksheets on the volume of Ac. Ft. of groundwater beneficially and reasonably used for irrigating and harvesting Lessee Bolthouse's carrots and onions on the Blum Trust leased parcels.
Steve Rodrigues.	Mr. Steve Rodrigues is the Lancaster Ranch Manager for Wm. Bolthouse Farms who was directly involved with the construction and operation of the groundwater pipeline delivery system from Bolthouse's 2 parcels onto the Blum Trust leased parcels. Mr. Rodrigues also met with Mr. Blum on site on 10/22/09 to view parcels
Michael Kovacevich,	Mr. Michael Kovacevich is the Ag. Properties Manager for Wm. Bolthouse Farms who communicated with Mr. Blum regarding Bolthouse's groundwater pipeline delivery system and groundwater Ac. Ft. usage. He also drafted Blum Trust's parcel map that identified the severed pipes from 2 parcels at the end of the term.
Sheldon Blum.	Mr. Sheldon Blum will testify regarding former lessee Wm. Bolthouse Farms' groundwater usage in irrigating and harvesting its carrots and onions on the Blum Trust leased parcels during the lease term; the intent, consideration and terms of the lease agreement; photographs taken of the leased parcels; & rebuttal issues.
Darren Filkens	Mr. Darren Filkins is the Director of Farming Operations for Bolthouse Farms who met with Mr. Blum on the Blum Trust parcels on 10/22/09 and observed pipeline casings on both Ave. J and 70th St. E. Mr. Filkins will establish that LAID 13-3 water well at APN:3384-008-020, and AVOL 14-3 NORTH & SOUTH water wells at 3384-004-004, were used to irrigate crops during the lease term.
