DECLARATION OF JOHN MACERI

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1. I am CEO of The People Concern, Inc., a California non-profit public benefit corporation. The People Concern, acting as agent for property owner Barrel Springs Properties, LLC, applied to the Antelope Valley Watermaster for approval of a new production well to be drilled on Barrel Springs Properties' land. The People Concern is presently and at all relevant times has been under contract with Barrel Springs Properties, LLC, to purchase the land at issue. The People Concern and Barrel Springs Properties are currently in escrow for this transaction. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein and, if called as a witness, could and would competently testify to the matters stated herein.

DECLARATION OF JOHN MACERI

- 2. On May 25, 2023, I attended an in-person meeting at AVEK, the Antelope Valley-East Kern Water Agency's offices, located in Palmdale, California.
- 3. The purpose of this meeting was for me and The People Concern's advisors, including counsel Claire Collins, and land use consultant Toby Waxman, to meet with Kathy MacLaren, the only member of the Antelope Valley Watermaster Board of Directors who voted "no" on Barrel Springs Properties' New Production Application at the Watermaster Board meeting held April 26, 2023.
- 4. My team asked to meet with Director MacLaren to understand and address her concerns, including the reason for her "no" vote.
- 5. Before the meeting, we learned that Robert Parris, who also serves on the Watermaster Board of Directors, wanted to attend because he had been unable to attend the April 26, 2023 Watermaster Board meeting.
- 6. After we arrived at AVEK's offices, we met with Robert Parris, Kathy MacLaren, Matt Knudson, and Craig Parton in a conference room.
- 7. Director MacLaren was seated at the head of the table when we came into the conference room; she did not rise to greet anyone. After initial pleasantries, which included my brief discussion with Director Parris about his interest in The People Concern's Kensington project in Palmdale, we sat down.

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- 8. Director Parris sat to Director MacLaren's right, on the opposite side of the oval conference room table. Mr. Parton sat to his right, directly opposite our counsel, Ms. Collins. I sat to Ms. Collins's left. Ms. Waxman sat between Ms. Collins and Director MacLaren, at the head, and Mr. Knudson sat to my left.
 - 9. The meeting was not productive.
- 10. Director MacLaren refused to engage in conversation about her vote. I asked her what her concerns were and the reasons for her "no" vote. She would not answer.
 - 11. Ms. Collins asked her these same questions and was met with similar stonewalling.
- 12. I told her that it "was a little disheartening when I personally reached out to you several times to answer your questions and got no response."
- 13. She stated that I was presuming she didn't know anything, that she knew a lot about the property, that she had talked to real estate agents in the area, and that she didn't want to talk to me. She also said that I "would just be putting my spin on it."
- 14. Every time Ms. Collins started to explain the reasons for the meeting, the basis for our application for a new well, and the findings of the Watermaster Engineer, Director MacLaren would cut her off, saying that she was not interested because "you're just going to put your spin on it," or words to that effect. Director MacLaren's tone was belligerent throughout.
- 15. After it became clear that Director MacLaren had no interest in hearing from us and no plans to explain her "no" vote, Ms. Collins told Mr. Parton that there was nothing further to discuss, said "we're done here," and asked to see him outside the meeting.
 - 16. We all stood up and Ms. Collins, Ms. Waxman, and Mr. Parton left the room.
- 17. Director Parris restarted our earlier conversation about the Kensington project and asked about coming to see our operation. I stepped around the table to shake his hand and say goodbye.
- 18. As I extended my hand to Director Parris, Director MacLaren began speaking in an aggressive voice.
- 19. Director MacLaren said, "Well, I noticed when you walked into the meeting, you didn't come over to shake my hand," Her tone was aggressive and unpleasant.

- 20. I turned to her and said, "I don't understand why you're making this so personal."
- 21. She then grabbed my hand and began pumping it aggressively, saying, "There, I shook your hand. It's not personal," before throwing my hand down.
 - 22. I was stunned by her lack of professionalism and said, "Wow, wow."
- 23. I then left the conference room, found Mr. Parton in the hall with Ms. Collins and Waxman, and told him, "I wish you could have seen what just happened in there. You have a client that's out of control."
