3	2. The Court finds that the Plaintiffs are entitled to recover their fees and costs under		
$4 \mid$	California CCP sections 1021.5 and 1033.5. Section 1021.5 authorizes the award of attorneys		
5	fees to a prevailing party when (1) the action has resulted in the enforcement of an important		
6	right affecting the public interest; (2) a significant benefit has been conferred on the general		
7	public or a large class of persons; and (3) the necessity and financial burden of private		
8	enforcement are such to make the award appropriate. Section 1033.5 lists items of costs		
9	allowable to the prevailing party.		
10	3. The Wllis Class has achieved a favorable settlement and is therefore a prevailing		
11	party. The settlement has resulted in the enforcement of an important public right that affected		
12	the public interest. A significant benefit has been conferred on the class of over 65,000		
13	landowners and the public at large. The necessity and financial burden of private enforcement		
14	are such to make an award appropriate. Class Counsel are also entitled to an award of costs in		
15	the amount of		
16	4. The hours expended and hourly rates claimed by Class counsel are reasonable.		
17	Given the contingent fee nature of the case and the substantial risks undertaken by Class		
18	Counsel, a 1.5 multiple of their lodestar is fair and reasonable.		
19	5. Upon consideration of the Motion and accompanying Declarations and based		
20	upon all matters of record including the pleadings and papers filed in this action, the Court		
21	hereby finds that the fee requested is reasonable and proper, and that the costs and expenses		
22	incurred by plaintiffs' counsel were necessary, reasonable and proper.
