1 Having read and considered the foregoing and following hearing on the motion, and good cause
2 appearing therefore,

3 IT IS ORDERED THAT:

4 1. Plaintiff Willis' motion for final approval of the proposed settlement between the
5 Willis Class and the Public Water Suppliers is granted. The Court finds that the settlement is fair
6 and reasonable to all affected parties.

7 2. The Court overrules the objections made to the settlement by Class Members
8 Bobb and D'Orio, as well as by AGWA and Bolthouse.

9 3. The Court finds that the settlement does not prejudice the legal rights of any non-
10 settling parties, and such parties retain any and all rights they currently have to contest any of the
11 issues as to which the Settling Parties agreed among themselves.

12 4. The Court approves the form of the Proposed Final Judgment, but defers entry of
13 that Judgment until plaintiff's motion for an award of fees is determined.
