Allan Graf forwarded your email to him and I have now reviewed it. Allan appropriately notified you that he is willing to talk to you as long as I am present as well. Allan is currently outside counsel for the Archdiocese of Los Angeles and, as you obviously are aware, my firm represents the Archdiocese in the Antelope Valley Groundwater Adjudication. Going forward, you and any other person at your firm (or any other defense firm) must communicate with me and Allan regarding the Antelope Valley matter.

You informed Allan that you would "like to discuss the existing Willis Class and the Archdiocese" and "the representation of the Archdiocese of Los Angeles in the Antelope Valley Groundwater Adjudication." We are not sure what you would like to discuss in that regard. Nonetheless, as always, we remain open to ongoing discussions regarding the incorporation of the Stipulation of Settlement between the Willis Class and the Public Water Suppliers, including District 40, into a proposed Physical Solution in a manner that is consistent with the Stipulation and Judgment.
