To All Parties and Their Counsel of Record:

During the July 29, 2013 Case Management Conference, Judge Komar directed counsel for Los Angeles County Waterworks District No. 40 (WD 40) to prepare and circulate to the landowners proposed questions relating to the purveyor's time frame for prescription, amount of claimed pumping, return flows and other pumping rights in the basin. WD 40 failed to do so. Accordingly, Tejon Ranch, Granite Construction Co., Diamond Farming Company, Crystal Organic Farms, Grimmway Enterprises, Inc. and Lapis Land Company are posting their proposed Discovery Order for Phase 5 Trial.
