- 2. The Small Pumper Class has a renewed motion for appoint of an expert witness set to be heard on April 24, 2009. The public water suppliers continue to oppose this motion. Because class counsel does not believe they can adequately prosecute this action without the testimony of an expert witness, should that motion be denied, class counsel has set a hearing on a motion to withdraw and to decertify the class for May 22, 2009. Counsel will file that motion, if needed, shortly after the ruling on the motion for appointment of an expert.
- 3. Over the past month, I, along with counsel for the Willis class, have made numerous written inquiries of counsel for Los Angeles Waterworks District No. 40 for information regarding the processing of the Willis claim forms and the assembly of the Small Pumper class list. I have received no response whatsoever to these inquiries. Today I conferred with Ralph Kalfayan and David Zlotnick on this issue, and they informed me that they have likewise received no response.
- 4. I request that, if the Small Pumper class is to proceed, the Court issue an order compelling the public water suppliers to immediately provide a detailed accounting of the status of the Willis class notice and the efforts taken to compile the Small Pumper notice list.
