20	RICHARD WOOD'S CONDITIONAL NON-OPPOSITION TO <i>EX PARTE</i> APPLICATION TO CONTINUE PHASE 5 TRIAL	

Plaintiff Richard Wood submits the following conditional non-opposition to the 1 Ex Parte Application to further continue the Phase 5 trial date. 2 Richard Wood generally believes the settlement discussions of February 19 3 through 21 were productive, but significant barriers remain unresolved, particularly with 4 the United States. The Court should not continue the remaining portion of the Phase 5 5 trial date unless there is a firm commitment by the parties, or order by the Court, that all 6 7 parties, including the United States, attend further settlement discussions on March 10, 2014, and continuing the remainder of that week until resolution or intractable impasse. 8 However, if the United States will not be in a position to meaningfully participate by 9 March 10, the Court should not continue the trial. 10 If the Court does order further discussions in lieu of trial next week, those 11 discussions should occur in Los Angeles. 12 As to the continued trial date, the proposed date of April 28, 2014 is not workable 13 due to a conflicting trial date of class counsel on another matter than has already been 14 thrice continued. Furthermore, that proposed date is too far out in time, and too close to 15 the Phase 6 trial date. Plaintiff suggests a new trial date of March 24, April 1, or April 7, 16 2014.
