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### **DECLARATION OF DANIEL O'LEARY**

I, Daniel O'Leary, declare:

1. I make this declaration of my own personal knowledge, except where stated on information and belief, and if called to testify in Court on these matters, I could do so competently.

## **QUALIFICATIONS**

2. I am co-counsel of record for Plaintiff Richard Wood and the Class and am duly licensed to practice law in California. I graduated from University of California, San Diego with a degree in mathematics, and from U.C.L.A. School of Law in 1994. I have been a Plaintiff's contingent attorney for over twenty-six years, specializing in complex litigation. I have tried many civil cases to verdict, resulting in excess of \$60 million in jury verdicts. I have handled approximately fifteen civil appeals, including this one.

#### WORK PERFORMED

- 3. I first came to work on this matter in May of 2008, and have participated in all the substantive litigation other than the phase 1 trial. I have previously submitted declarations and billing records documenting my time on this matter through the end of June 2016. (Appendix, Exs. F, Q, and T.) This declaration documents time spend on this matter, including time spend securing my fees, since July 2016. The vast bulk of this time was spent dealing with the appeal and cross-appeal of the Wood Class fee awards.
- 4. The time sheet attached as **Exhibit 1** was maintained contemporaneously. I have included time spent on matters related to parties with which the Wood Class has resolved all its claims. Where time was spent on matters solely related to these parties, I have kept the entries in the timesheets, but removed the time from the total sought by this Motion. For example, the entries of November 4, 2019 and November 14, 2019 involved work related solely to parties that have settled, so the entry for those days reflects zero hours.

## DECLARATION OF DANIEL O'LEARY

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- 5. To date, I have 136.6 hours of post-judgment appellate and postremand time, and estimate I will spend another 15 hours working on reply briefs, and preparing for and attending the hearing on these motions.
- 6. When submitting fee declarations in 2016, I stated that the total time substantially understates the actual effort and time involved in the representation of the Class. With a few exceptions, Mr. McLachlan and I did not both bill for the same task and we did not bill at all for what were probably hundreds of conversations and email exchanges about the appeals, the briefs, the oral argument, the review and assessment of the court of appeal opinion, and the petition and answer for review filed in the Supreme Court.
- I have worked on this case for nearly fourteen years with no 7. compensation or cost reimbursement from Los Angeles County Waterworks District 40, the primary adversary of the Wood Class. Nevertheless, we have represented the Class zealously and achieved a result that will allow small domestic pumpers in the area of adjudication to continue to pump water without the threat of prescriptive claims or, generally, assessments. Both the trial court and court of appeal agreed that we are entitled to fees for our work.
- 8. I am confident that no attorney would have undertaken this representation knowing in advance that the bulk of fees and costs would not be paid for nearly fourteen years.
- 9 To echo my prior declarations, there is a wide array of relevant facts that justify the full amount of fees we have requested for the work on appeal. Generally, they are: the case's long duration (eight years in the trial court, nearly six more on appeal, with the risk of further appeal), the risks of loss and uncertainty, the high quality and great efficiency of the work, the excellent outcome for the Class members, the inability to take on other business, as well as the financial toll this case has taken on my office. They all weigh in favor of a 1.5 multiplier for the appellate and post-remand work sought in this motion.
