Public Water Suppliers oppose Richard Wood's and the Antelope Valley Ground Water Agreement Association's ex parte application regarding the testimony of Joseph Scalmanini as follows:

I. INTRODUCTION

Richard Wood and the Antelope Valley Ground Water Agreement Association have set and ex parte application to be heard on December 31, 2010, a court holiday. December 31, 2010 is a court holiday in both Los Angeles and Santa Clara counties, see Exhibit One.

II. DECEMBER 31, 2010 IS A COURT HOLIDAY AND CLOSED TO JUDICIAL BUSINESS

California Government Code section 6700(b) states that January 1st is a California holiday. In the year 2011, January 1st falls on a Saturday, so pursuant to California Rule of Court 1.11, this is observed on the proceeding Friday, which is December 31, 2011. This recognized by the Los Angeles and Santa Clara counties, as stated on Exhibit 1.

Pursuant to California Civil Code section 134(a) the courts are closed to judicial business on holidays. This court cannot hear Mr. Wood's or AGWA's ex part application on December 31, 2010, since that day is a court holiday.

III. THE COURT ACTS IN EXCESS OF ITS JURISDICTION TO PROCEED ON A HOLIDAY

When a court purports to conduct business on a judicial holiday, all rulings of the court on that day are nullities. This goes so far as to included pronouncing judgment in a criminal case. "There is no doubt that a judgment of conviction which is pronounced on a holiday over the express objection of an accused person is void." People v. Browning (1933) 132 Cal.App. 136, 141. In Browning, the Court observed that rendering a judgment on over the express objection of a party was void; in the particular case, the objection had been waived, but without such a waiver, entry of judgment would have been void.

Here, the Public Water Suppliers explicitly object to the ex parte application of Mr. Wood and AGWA, or any other judicial business to take place on December 31, 2010 because that day is a Court holiday. Additionally, the relief requested in the ex parte is not of such a pressing nature that the Court's decision on a holiday is needed. Not all counsel will be able to attend as many will have scheduled personal activities away from work and therefore their parties will be prejudiced by the holding of a hearing on a holiday. The issue can be fully addressed on Monday, January 3, 2011, which is a regularly-scheduled day for holding court business.

IV. **CONCLUSION**

The Public Water Suppliers respectfully request that the Court not conduct any hearing on December 31, 2010. If this objection is overruled, the Public Water Suppliers request the proceedings be stenographically recorded.
